Arizona Baseball College World Series Game Notes

2012 Record: 46-17 (20-10, Pac-12 Co-Champions)

Arizona-South Carolina History: The two schools have never met ... The last time Arizona played an SEC team at the CWS was in 2004. The Wildcats lost an opening game to Georgia, 8-7, defeated Arkansas, 7-2, in an elimination game and lost again to Georgia, 3-1, at the 2004 College World Series ... Arizona played one series against an SEC team in 2012, taking two of three from Auburn at Hi Corbett Field in Tucson in February.

CWS Championship Games: Arizona is making its seventh all-time appearance in the College World Series championship round, though its first in the new best-of-three format which started up in the 21st Century ... The Wildcats have finished runner-up three times (1956, 1959 and 1963) under coach Frank Sancet, while the school won titles in 1976, 1980 and 1986 under Jerry Kindred ... Interestingly, all three national title clubs entered the championship game with one loss in Omaha ... Andy Lopez will make his second appearance in the national title game(s), after leading Pepperdine to the 1992 national championship.

CWS Notables: Arizona is appearing in its 16th all-time College World Series ... The Wildcats are now 36-27 all-time ... Arizona is playing in its first best-of-three championship series in Omaha. ... UA's 10-3 victory last Thursday night was the school's sixth (in seven tries) against Florida State in Omaha ... Last Sunday's 4-0 win over UCLA marked the first time UA played the Bruins in Omaha ... The last time a UA team recorded a shutout at the CWS was in an 8-0 victory over Michigan on June 2, 1980 ... The Wildcats won their CWS opening game for just the second time in their last four appearances ... The last time UA won its opening game in Omaha was in 1986 when the school claimed its third national championship ... UA's four runs scored in each of its first two games marked the fewest in a CWS victory for the school since also defeating Florida State by the same score, 4-3, on June 11, 1963 (19 wins in between) ... The last time the Wildcats won their first three CWS games was in 1986, when UA started 3-0, dropped a 4-2 decision to Miami and defeated Florida State, 10-2, in the national championship game.

Wade's World Away From Home: Sunday's scheduled starter, Konner Wade, has fared much better away from home this season and in his career. In 2012, Wade has a 3-1 record, a 3.47 ERA and three complete games in six starts on the road/neutral. In his career, Wade boasts a 4-1 record and a 2.91 ERA in nine career starts away from home (22 ER in 68.0 IP) ... Wade's complete-game shutout without a walk was the first in CWS play since 1972 (Craig Swan of ASU) ... Wade became the first UA pitcher to throw a shutout in a CWS game since Craig Lefferts (June 2, 1980) in an 8-0 victory over Michigan (also school's last CWS shutout win) ... Wade, who has a team-high 36 walks this season, has pitched 25.1 innings since his last walk.

Staying Hot: Arizona has won 16 of its last 18 games dating back to early May. The Wildcats have hit .325 over the last 18 games, and have outscored opponents 41-11 in two-out RBI. On the mound, UA hurlers have a 2.78 ERA, 109 strikeouts and just 43 walks in 165.0 innings pitched. Starters have combined for seven complete games in those 18 contests. Defensively, Arizona boasts a .984 fielding percentage with just 11 errors committed, compared to 37 errors by opponents. Lastly, the Wildcats have done it all at home and on the road. Arizona went 7-1 at home and is 9-1 on the road/neutral over those final 18 games.

Arizona Head Coach Andy Lopez: The Wildcats are coached by Andy Lopez, who is now in his 11th season with a 401-246-1 record at the school. He has guided the Wildcats to postseason competition in eight of the last 10 years, including three straight NCAA regionals, and highlighted College World Series appearances in 2004 and now 2012. The Wildcats have won at least 30 games in six straight years and in 10 of Lopez's 11 seasons at the school, and have won 40 games in three of the last six seasons. Overall, Lopez has more than 1,000 career victories, one national championship and four College World Series appearances. Lopez owns a career record of 1,086-664-7 in 30 years as a head coach, including stints at Cal State Dominguez Hills (1983-88), Pepperdine (1989-94), Florida (1995-2001) and Arizona (2002-present). Lopez led Pepperdine, Florida (twice) and Arizona (twice) to College World Series appearances. His total victories are 13th-most among active coaches and he is just one of just 45 individuals to reach 1,000 career victories.

Lopez Wins No. 400: Arizona's 11th-year head coach Andy Lopez (400-246-1) collected his 400th career victory at the school in the 4-0 victory over UCLA last Sunday. Lopez is the third-winningest coach in school history behind Hall of Fame coaches Jerry Kindall (860) and Frank Sancet (831). J.F. "Pop" McKale won 304 ballgames and Jerry Stitt won 157. Lopez and those other four distinguished skipper comprise the total of five head coaches the program has had since 1922, which covers 91 seasons.

Complete Games: Arizona has received 15 complete games from its trio of starting pitchers – Kurt Heyer (7), Konner Wade (5) and James Farris (3) ... The 15 CG's match the entire total from the SEC (15), while Michael Roth accounts for South Carolina's only CG of the season ... The Wildcats' 15 complete games in 2012 are the most for the program since throwing 22 in 1989 ... Combined with seven complete games a year ago, Arizona's 21 CG's the last two seasons are more than half of the 32 the school combined to throw in the first 11 years of the 21st century (2000-10) ... Kurt Heyer's three consecutive complete games in April were more than UA had as a team in four of the six seasons prior to the season (2010, 2009, 2008 and 2006) ... Heyer's seven complete games in 2012 are more than UA combined for as a team in a three-year stretch from 2008-10 ... The last UA pitcher to earn a victory in three consecutive complete game outings was RHP Troy Bradford at the end of the 1990 season ... Kurt Heyer (7), Konner Wade (5) and James Farris (3) have combined for 15 complete games. The last time three UA pitchers had 3+ complete games in a season was in 1989 (Scott Erickson – 14, Lance Dickson – 4 and Jim Richardson – 3).

The Bullpen: As Andy Lopez said following the CWS-opening 4-3 victory over Florida State, "We do not win tonight without (Tyler) Crawford and (Mathew) Troupe doing what they did." The two freshman relievers combined to throw 4.1 scoreless innings of relief against the Seminoles, with just two hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts. The poise of the rookies was impressive on such a big stage, but was also notable since they had thrown 1.2 innings in five postseason games coming in. Those 1.2 innings accounted for the only two appearances by UA relievers in the post season and both came from Crawford and Troupe. In five combined postseason appearances, the classmates have thrown a combined 7.2 innings with seven strikeouts, no walks, six hits and just one run allowed (1.17 ERA). Junior Stephen Manthei, who had a team high 23 appearances in the regular season, has yet to be used in the postseason.

10-Game Winners: Konner Wade earned his 10th victory of the season with his 4-0 shutout against UCLA last Sunday night. Along with Kurt Heyer, Arizona has a pair of 10-game winners for the first time since 2005 when John Meloan (10-3) and Kevin Guyette (10-4) each had double-digit tallies. Andy Lopez has now coached a pitcher to a 10 or more victories in a season seven times at Arizona. With 13 wins – most in the nation this season – Heyer ties five other Wildcats for eighth-most in single season history at Arizona. The last of that group to do so was Joe Magrane in 1985. Scott Erickson won 18 games in 1989, most-ever in a single season at the school.

Last At-Bat Wins: Eight of Arizona's 46 victories, including five of its 20 Pac-12 wins, have come with a rally in its final at-bat of a game. In fact, four of the wins have come in the last nine games, including in the opening game of the Tucson Super Regional and the opening game of the CWS.

- May 27 vs. Arizona St. (UA scores run in Bot. 9, wins 8-7 in walk-off fashion)
- June 8 vs. St. John's (UA scores twice in Bot 10, wins 7-6 in walk-off fashion)
- June 15 vs. Florida State (UA scores once in Top 12, wins 4-3).

UA-Florida State Postgame Notes

- Kurt Heyer's 153 innings pitched this year make him the third Wildcat in history to pitch 150 innings or more behind single-season record holder Scott Erickson (172.2 in 1989) and Gil Heredia (165.1 in 1986). His 13-game victory total is tied for No. 8 in UA history and first of that total since Joe Magrane went 13-8 for UA in its 1985 CWS season. Scott Erickson set the school record a few years later with 18 wins in 1989.
- Arizona is on a season-high nine-game winning streak, its longest since a 15-game stretch in March of 2010.
- Arizona had a season-high 15 runners left on base against Florida State.
- The 10 runs were the most in World Series action for Arizona since June 9, 1986, also against Florida State, when the Cats won the NCAA title game 10-2.
- Arizona entered the game hitting .219 in CWS play and left the game hitting .277.
- Arizona has had an extra-base hit in 62 of its 63 games in 2012.
- The two home runs were the first time UA had multiple blasts since May 12 at Cal's cozy Evans Diamond. It was the second time this season the Cats had two in one inning. The other time was March 24 at Oregon State with yard balls by Brown and Riley Moore, back-to-back.
- UA's big first inning was its seventh inning of at least four runs in NCAA action this year. It also was the Cats' 19th multiple-run inning in the postseason. The fourth inning made it an eighth of at least four runs, and 20th of multiple run scoring.
- FSU's run in the fourth snapped a streak of 18-and-a-third scoreless innings by UA pitchers in Omaha, since the sixth inning Heyer pitched in UA's CWS opener against FSU.
- Arizona improved to 11-3 vs. lefty starters this year.
- The Cats' 15 hits gave them double-digit hits in seven of eight postseason games.
- Leadoff hitter Joey Rickard recorded his sixth multiple-hit game in those eight contests.
- Johnny Field recorded his 10th outfield assist and third of the postseason when he threw out Sherman Johnson trying to double in the top of the first.
- Field, who extended his hitting streak to 14 games, reached base for the 27th consecutive game.
- Alex Mejia's steal of third base in the first was his fourth in four tries in NCAA play this year and made him 8-14 overall in 2012.
- Robert Refsnyder has reached base in 37 consecutive games. His steals in the first and second innings gave him 14 swipes in 18 tries. They also helped give UA three SBs or more in 13 games this year and matched the postseason high of three against Louisville on June 2.
- Arizona drew four walks in the first two innings Thursday against Florida State, as many as it had in the first two CWS outings for the Cats. Also, the Cats have drawn 37 walks in postseason play.
- Arizona got at least seven innings from its starting pitcher for the eighth time in the postseason -- each of the Cats' NCAA contests.
