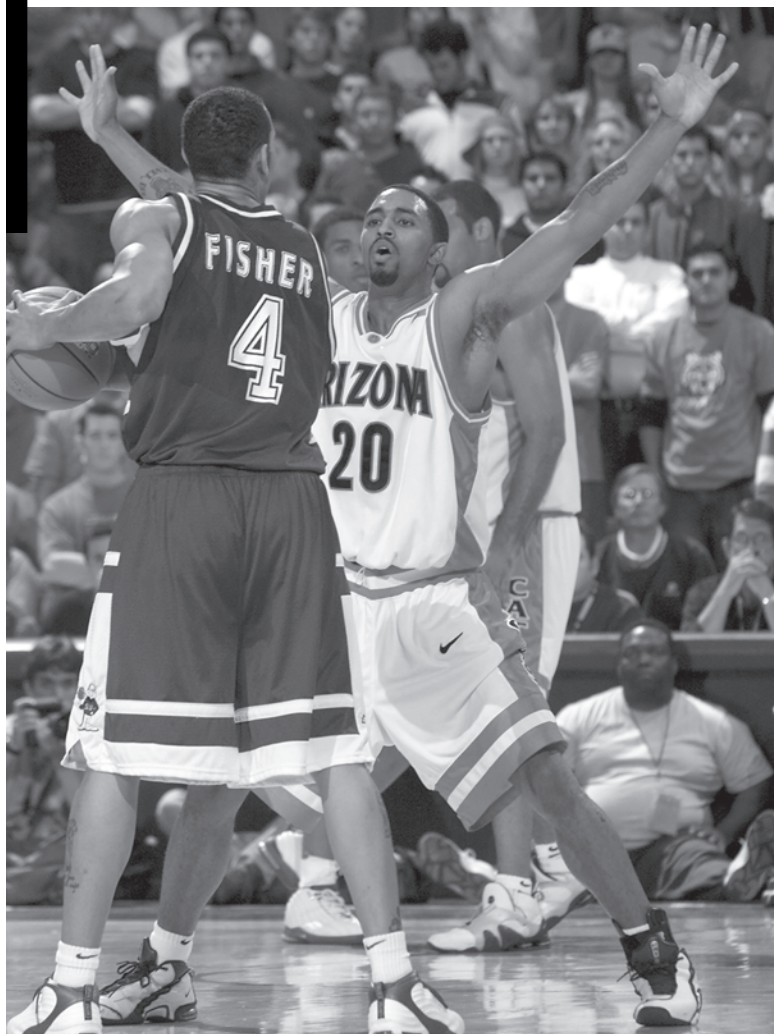

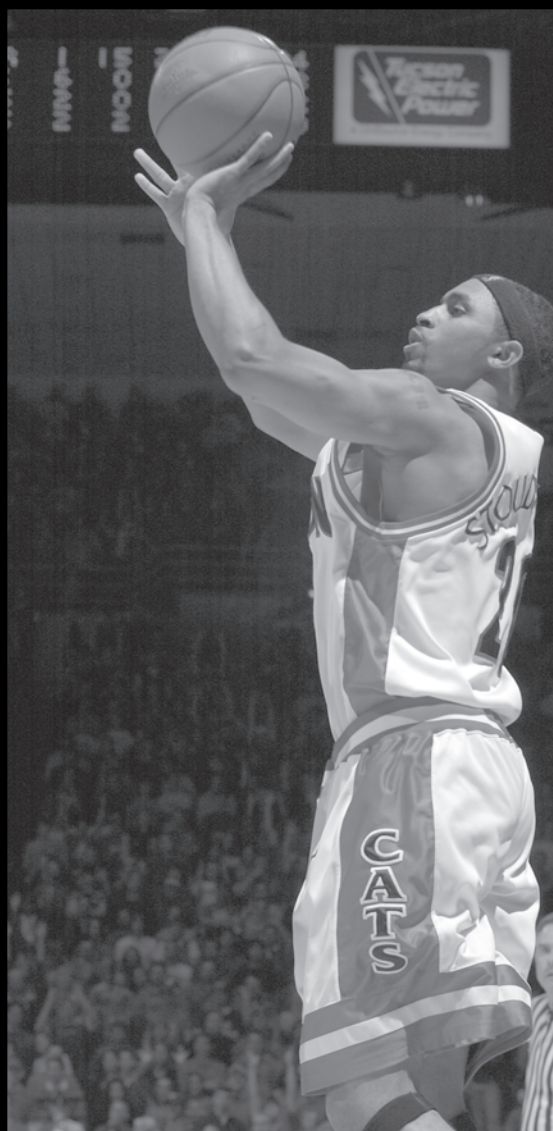

Led UA with 71 treys ... Ranked third in the Pac-10 with a 44.4 three-point FG percentage ... Shot 50.8 percent from the floor (94-of-185) in his last 20 games ... Fourth in the Pac-10 with an .864 FT percentage (70-of-81) ... Named Pac-10 Player of the Week on March 3 after averaging 19.0 points and shooting 58.3 percent from the floor in Bay Area sweep ... Named Arizona best defensive player in a vote of his teammates ... Hit just 1-of-4 attempts vs. Kansas in the West Regional final on 3/29 ... Tallied 11 points on 4-of-6 shooting

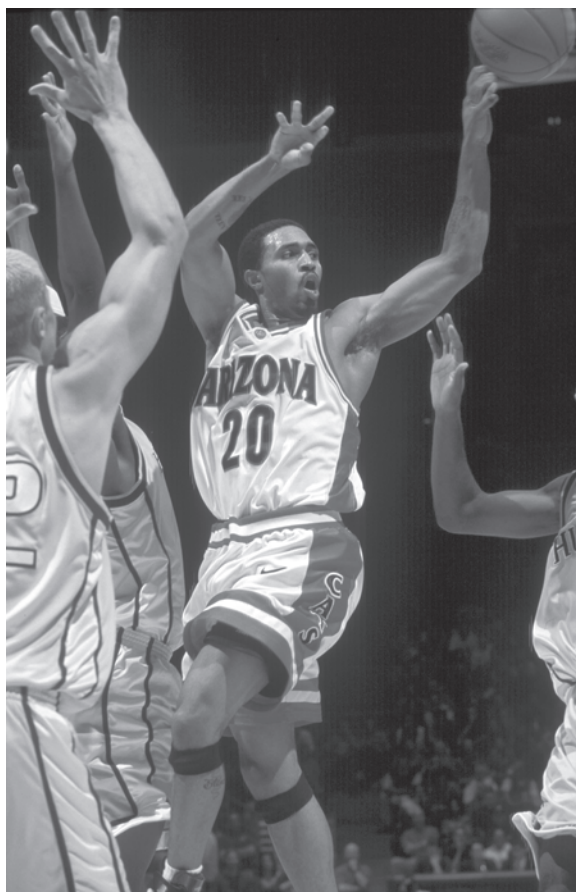

Summer 2002: Averaged 16.3 points and 2.4 rebounds per game on Arizona's 10-game tour of Australia though he saw action in only nine contests ... Shot 39.1 percent (25-of-64) from the international three-point line, but did connect on 13 of his last 27 attempts ... Finished in double figures seven times, including the last six consecutive ... Averaged 24.0 points over the last four games of the tour, while shooting 54.1 percent from the floor in that span.



2001-02 (Freshman): Posted one of the strongest freshman campaigns in UA history ... Made 28 starts and averaged 12.8 points per game to earn Pac-10 Freshman-of-the Year accolades (the fourth Wildcat to be so honored) ... Set a new school record and ranked fourth nationally with a 90.4 free throw percentage in 2001-02 ... Earned Mr. Hustle and Best Defensive Player honors in a vote of his teammates ... His 434 points as a freshman ranks sixth in UA history ... Named Pac-10 Conference Freshman of the Year ... Named to the Pac-10 all-Tournament team, after shooting 66.7 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from three-point range... Arguably, the team's best on-ball defender ... Earned second team all-Freshman honors from *Basketball News* ... Ranked fourth nationally in FT percentage at .904 (103-of-114) and set a new single-season school record in the process ... Finished the season ranked 19th in the Pac-10 in scoring (12.5), first in free throw percentage (.904), third in 3-point FG percentage (.453) and 3-point FGs made (2.15) ... Broke the UA school record with 39 consecutive free throws (streak ended Jan. 26) ... Ranks second on the UA career three-point FG percentage list at .453 ... One of five UA players to average in double figures (12.8) ... Averaged 30.0 minutes per game, most of any freshman ... Collected the most double-figure scoring games (22) of any of the UA freshmen ... Did not start for the first time in 15 games (dating back to Dec. 20) on Feb. 7 vs. Washington for arriving late to the team shootaround ... Connected on 106-of-217 (.488) FG attempts in his last 27 games, including 60-of-122 (.492) from three-point range ... Hit just 2-of-8 FGs on 3/21 vs. Oklahoma in the West Regional Semifinal ... Collected seven points and two steals vs. Wyoming on 3/16 ... Tallied 12 points and four rebounds in his NCAA Tournament debut vs. UCSB on 3/14 ... Sizzled in the Pac-10 Tournament championship game by scoring 29 points on 9-of-10 FG shooting (5-of-6) from three-point range on 3/9 vs. USC ... Tallied 10 points, three boards and a steal on 3/7 vs. Arizona State in the quarterfinals of the Pac-10 Tournament ... Hit 5-of-7 FG attempts en route to 15 points vs. California on 3/2 ... Went 6-of-9 from the floor and 9-of-10 from the line en route to a team-high 24 points vs. Arizona State on 2/20 ... Hit 6-of-8



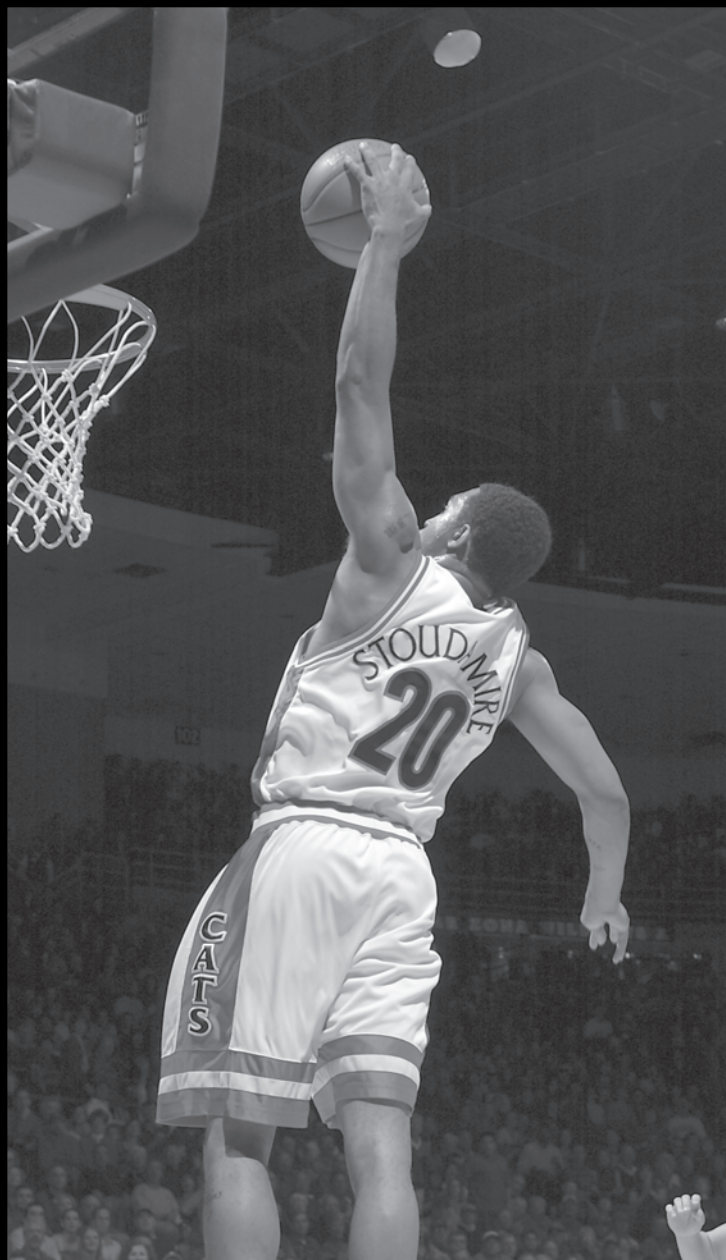

Named to the Fiesta Bowl Classic All-Tournament team after hitting 5-of-7 FGs to finish with 13 points in a career high 38 minutes vs. Valpo on 12/30 ... Exploded for a game-high 25 points on 9-of-13 shooting (5-of-9 3-pt.) to go with four boards and two steals vs. Pepperdine on 12/28 ... Broke out of his shooting slump with a 4-of-7 FG night at Oregon on

12/22, including 2-of-3 from three-point range and finished with 12 points ... Struggled from the floor on 12/1 vs. Kansas, connecting on just 2-of-19 FG attempts to finished with six points, two assists and two steals ... Scored a career-high 19 points (all in second half) and added three rebounds in the win at No. 23 Texas on 11/17 ... Hit all four FTs en route to seven points in the win over No. 5 Florida on 11/9 ... Scored nine of his 12 points to open the second half in the win over No. 2 Maryland on 11/8.

High School: The Oregon Class 4A all-time leading scorer with 2,219 career points, Stoudamire is the cousin of former UA All-American (1992-95)





and 1996 NBA Rookie of the Year Damon Stoudamire ... A McDonald's All-American ... Was rated as the No. 66 recruit in the nation and the No. 15 shooting guard in the nation by Fast Break Recruiting Service and *HoopScoop* magazine ... Averaged 28.5 points (a state high), 6.0 rebounds and 3.9 assists per game as a senior at Lake Oswego High School ... Helped team to a berth in the state finals ... A first team all-state pick as a junior and senior ... Team went 13-3 in conference play, 17-10 overall ... Stoudamire was named Three Rivers League Player of the Year and played in the Washington/Oregon All-Star game ... Averaged 23.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game as a junior for coach Mark Schoff at Lake Oswego High School in leading the squad to a state tournament semifinal berth ... He was a first-team all-state selection and the Three Rivers Conference Player of the Year as a junior ... Stoudamire was an all-conference pick in each of his four years in high school ... Averaged 28.6 points as a freshman and 21.7 points as a sophomore.

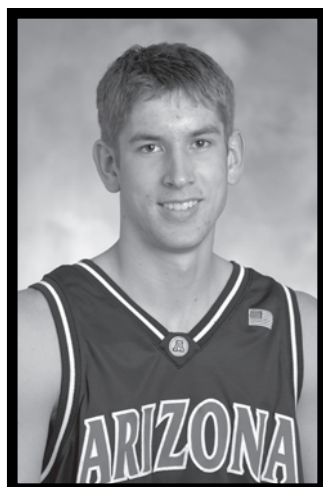

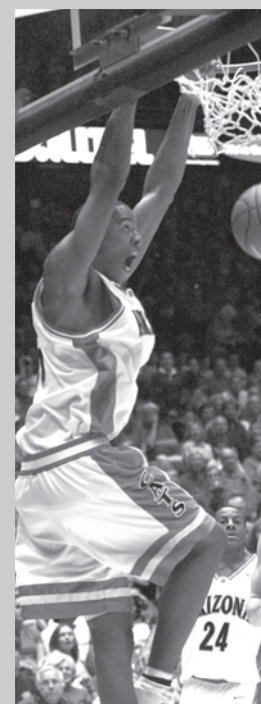
