Arizona vs Memphis Post-Game Notes March 18, 2011

General Notes...

**Today's game marked the eighth meeting between Arizona and Memphis. The series is now tied at 4-4, with Arizona having won 4 of the last 5. This was their first meeting in an NCAA Tournament game.

**Arizona will advance to meet Texas in Sunday's third round matchup at a time TBD. Arizona and Texas have met 10 times, with Arizona holding an 8-2 series advantage, including eight victories in a row. The last meeting came in 2004 (a 91-83 AU win) and the teams have never met in the NCAA Tournament.

Arizona Notes...

**Arizona advanced to the second round for the 16th time since the field was expanded in 1985.

**Arizona now has 42 wins in the NCAA Tournament since the field was expanded in 1985. That is the sixth-highest total among all Division I programs.

**Arizona is now 60-30 (.667) in the month of March since the 1996-97 season. That includes a 27-14 (.658) record in NCAA Tournament games over that span. Under head coach Sean Miller, Arizona is now 7-3 (.700) in March.

**This was the sixth time this season that Arizona has won after trailing by seven points or more. Memphis held a 21-11 lead at the 11:48 mark of the first half.

**Derrick Williams recorded his 11th double-double of the season, finishing with 22 points and 10 rebounds. It was his eighth game this season with 20 or more points and 10 or more rebounds.

**Lamont Jones reached double figures for the 16th time this season and scored 15 or more for the seventh time, finishing with 18 points.

**After trailing 26-20 at the 6:36 mark, Arizona closed out the first half on a 21-12 run.

**Arizona is now 7-2 this season in games decided by five points or less.

Memphis Notes...

**Memphis lost its first NCAA Tournament first-round game for the first time since 2003 vs. Arizona State.

**Today was Antonio Barton's 13th game in double-digit scoring. He finished with a team-high 17 points.

**Will Barton scored in double figures for the 15th time in the last 19 games and the 23rd time overall. He finished with 12 points.

**Memphis fell to 13-2 in games decided by five points or less this season.

**The Tigers opened the game by hitting 7 of their first 10 shots from the field, but finished the remainder of the first half 4-of-13.

**After Arizona took its biggest lead of the game at 48-40 with 16:25 remaining, Memphis went on a 13-0 run to size the lead back.

**Memphis was held without a field goal from the 7:25 mark to the 2:51 mark, a span of 4:34. Tarik Black finished the dry spell with a bucket and a free throw that tied the game at 68-68.
