### Cats Make 25th NCAA Postseason Appearance in Last 26 Years

**In the Clubhouse:** The Arizona men's golf team competed in the 2012 NCAA Southwest Regional, making its 25th postseason appearance in the last 26 seasons, including 23 NCAA Regional berths since the format was adopted in 1989 ... Along the way, the Wildcats picked up one team win – Jan. 31 at the Arizona Intercollegiate – and earned 12 individual top-10 finishes.

**The Rankings:** The Wildcats finished the season ranked 61st in the final (June 2) *Golfweek/Sagarin* Performance Index, and received votes in the last recent (week of May 21) *Golf World/Nike* Coaches Poll. Individually, junior Juan Pablo Hernandez was the top-ranked Wildcat nationally, checking in at No. 159 on the *Golfweek/Sagarin* Performance Index. Sophomore Erik Oja was next at No. 181.

**Head Coach Rick LaRose** ... completed his 34th season at the helm of the Arizona golf program, and in that span established the Wildcats as one of the nation's elite programs. The only college coach to win both a men's (1992) and women's (1996) NCAA Championship, LaRose's teams have won a combined nine NCAA Regionals, six Pac-10 crowns and three Rolex Match Play titles. In NCAA Championship play, he also has six third-place finishes, two fifth-place and two sixth-place efforts to his credit. Since 1978, his men's teams have won 62 tournaments and produced 47 All-Americans. LaRose, who has coached two U.S. Amateur champions, was inducted into the Golf Coaches Association of America Hall of Fame on Jan. 22, 2003, and the Arizona Golf Hall of Fame on Nov. 23, 2009. He was assisted by Andy Barnes.

**Last Time Out:** UA finished in a tie for ninth place at the 2012 NCAA Southwest Regional in Norman, Okla. The Wildcats, seeded 11th in the field, shot a final-round 302 (+14) total on May 19 to tie San Diego for ninth place in the 14-team field with a 902 (+38) total. Washington carded a five-over-par 293 to win the regional with an 860 (-4) total, four strokes ahead of second-place Texas. UW's Chris Williams shot a final-round 68 to come from behind and claim individual medalist honors with a 209 (-7) total. Arizona was led by junior Juan Pablo Hernandez, who tallied a one-over 73 and finished in a tie for 35th place at 226 (+10). His 73 was Arizona's low round of the day and moved him 15 spots up the leaderboard. Sophomore Erik Oja was the Cats' top finisher, tying for 24th place at six-over 222. He was Arizona's top finisher in five of UA's last six events. He finished two shots ahead of teammate Tucker Wadkins, who tied for 31st place at eight-over 224.

The result capped the 39-year coaching career of Rick LaRose, including the last 34 seasons as Arizona's golf coach, who had announced April 24 that he was retiring at season's end.

**A Numbers Game:** As mentioned above, the NCAA Regional appearance was the final one for Rick LaRose as the Arizona golf coach. In a game defined by numbers, LaRose's accomplishments practically boggle the mind. In addition to winning a pair of national championships, he also won more than 6,100 head-to-head matches at a better than .700 winning percentage. Further, LaRose's teams won seven NCAA regional championships, four Pac-10 crowns and three Rolex Match Play titles. Since 1978, his golf teams have won 62 men's tournaments and 19 women's tourneys, producing seven national players of the year, 11 Pac-10 players of the year, 68 All-Americans, 109 all-Pac-10 Conference performers, two United States Amateur winners and five United States Walker Cup players. Prior to taking over as the men's golf coach in 1978, LaRose spent five seasons as UA's men's water polo coach and posted a .803 winning percentage in that span. His 39-year tenure at Arizona is the second longest for a head coach in school history.

**Pac-12 All-Academic:** A total of four Arizona golfers were named to the Pac-12 Conference's All-Academic team, which was released June 7. Senior Kenji Hernandez and sophomore Erik Oja were selected to the first team, while junior Trent Redfern was a second-team pick and senior Philip Bagdade was an honorable mention honoree. Bagdade (2010, '11, '12), Hernandez (2010, '11, '12) and Redfern (2011, '12) have now earned multiple conference all-academic accolades in their respective careers.

**Atop the Leaderboard:** Arizona is no stranger to the top of the leader board, especially as a team. The Wildcats claimed the Arizona Intercollegiate, Jan. 31, by a stroke with an 835 (-17) total. It was the 72nd win in program history and the first since February of last year. It marks the third straight season in which the Wildcats have won at least one team tournament.

**Top Cat:** When it comes to leading the squad, no Wildcat was better than sophomore Erik Oja, who closed the season by being the top-finishing UA player in seven events, including five of the last six outings. He tied for 24th place at the 2012 NCAA Southwest Regional, May 17-19 in Norman, Okla., with a six-over 22 total. Over the last six tournaments played, Oja led Arizona with a 71.63 scoring average. He finished the year with a 72.65 stroke average, a figure that was 1.59 strokes lower per round than his average as a freshman.

**What a Difference a Year Makes:** Juan Pablo Hernandez was Arizona's most consistent player, leading the team in scoring average (72.56), rounds at par or better (21), rounds counted toward the team total (41/95%), and sharing the lead in top-10 (4) and top-20 finishes (3). Perhaps most impressively, the junior from Mexico City, Mexico, has turned himself into a very productive player. As a sophomore, Hernandez posted a 75.00 stroke average, collected one top-10 and two top-20 finishes and had 10 rounds at par or better. A year later, his stroke average dropped by 2.44 stroke per round and the aforementioned statistical categories showed dramatic improvements. His runner-up finish Jan. 31 at the Arizona Intercollegiate was the best placing by a UA golfer this season, and he finished the season as UA's top-ranked golfer on the Golfweek/Sagarin Performance Index. He joined Erik Oja as the only two Wildcats to see action in all 43 varsity rounds.

## Sub 70

Nine Arizona golfers tallied 34 rounds in the 60s this season. That amounts to 65 percent of the 52 career rounds in the 60s collected by members of the 2012 Wildcats. A complete list is included below.

**Under Par:** Twice during the 2011-12 campaign Arizona finished a tournament under par – a 17-under 835 to open the spring at the Arizona Intercollegiate and a four-under 836 to close the regular season at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic. All told, the Cats registered eight under-par rounds as a team in 12 stroke play events with the lowest single round in relation to par, 277 (-7), occurring twice on Jan. 30 as the Cats played 36 holes to open play at the Arizona Intercollegiate an event the squad eventually won by a shot.

**A Strong Push:** Freshman Tucker Wadkins capped his collegiate debut campaign very well, posting a 72.50 stroke average over his last 10 rounds, including five rounds at par or better. The native of Dallas, Texas, competed in 13 events (40) rounds and collected 13 rounds at par or better and one top-10 and one top-20 finish. Further, his 74.28 stroke average is tied for 24th in school history for freshmen. Of the 23 players ahead of him on the list, only 10 played as many as Wadkins' 40 rounds as a freshman.

**Making A Move:** It's not unexpected that the three guys with the most rounds played were also the leaders when it came to spring scoring averages. And that's exactly

what happened when Erik Oja, Juan Pablo Hernandez and Tucker Wadkins posted 72.48, 72.65 and 73.61 stroke averages, respectively, in 29 combined spring appearances. When compared to their season-long stroke averages, Wadkins showed the most improvement, posting a spring stroke average that was 0.67 strokes lower. As a team, Arizona's countable stroke average was 73.05 in 10 spring events, an improvement of 0.5 strokes per round over its four fall events.

**Good Starts:** If one was to look for the Wildcat most likely to post a good first-round number, look no further than freshman Tucker Wadkins, who has been at par or better in the opening round in four of his last six tournaments, averaging a 70.83 in those first six 18-hole treks. However, as a team, the round-by-round statistics show that Arizona was more of a second-round club. In 14 stroke play events, the Wildcats' lowest scoring round on average is the second with an adjusted average of 290.52. The Cats average 290.92 strokes in round one and post a third-round average of 296.60. Not surprisingly, Arizona's low round of any tournament was registered in the second round seven times (including one tie), while it's high round appeared in the third seven times.

**Strong to the Finish:** Senior Philip Bagdade made the most of his opportunity, as 24 of his 30 rounds played in 2011-12 came this spring. In that span, the native of Eugene, Ore., posted a 74.75 stroke average and collected his lone top-20 finish of the season. He is the only Arizona Wildcat on the roster to make three career NCAA Regional appearances. A respectable 79 percent (15-of-19) of his varsity rounds played counted towards the team total. Also a standout off the course, Bagdade was the recipient of the UA Athletic Department's C.A.T.S (Commitment to an Athlete's Total Success) Life Skills Career Achievement Award for his community service efforts.

**Low Tournament Totals:** When it came to low tournament totals, here are the five lowest registered by the Wildcats in 2011-12. The best individual finish among these five scores was registered by Juan Pablo Hernandez, who finished in second place at the Arizona Intercollegiate.

**A Noteworthy Accomplishment:** As shown above, Brenden Redfern's seven-under 203 total at the Wyoming Cowboy Classic was UA's low 54-hole total of the season, but it also put the freshman in some elite company. The aggregate total equaled the 14th lowest score in school history, while Redfern's final-round, six-under 64 on April 10 equaled the ninth-lowest aggregate round in school history and was UA's low round of the season.

**Similar Features:** Brothers Trent and Brenden Redfern posted similar numbers during the season. Trent, a junior, finished 2011-12 with a 74.97 stroke average with 10 rounds at par or better and a low round of 67. Brenden, a freshman, tallied a 75.05 stroke average with seven rounds at par or better, including a low round of 64. The natives of Austin, Texas, each collected one top-10 and one top-20 finish. The duo combined to play 76 rounds in 2011-12, and 62 of those rounds were played at the same events.

**In Flux:** With only two players – Juan Pablo Hernandez and Erik Oja – seeing action in all 14 varsity events, it would be a safe assumption that UA's regular lineup saw more than its fair share of change over the course of the 2011-12 campaign. But that wasn't quite the case, as only eight players saw action as part of UA five-man or six-man lineups. Another seven players competed alongside the varsity, competing in events as individuals.

## William H. Tucker Intercollegiate (T4th of 16 teams)

Led by Erik Oja, the University of Arizona men's golf team finished in a tie for fourth place at the William H. Tucker Intercollegiate in Albuquerque, N.M.

Oja, a sophomore from Sandviken, Sweden, carded a one-under 71 Saturday to move into a tie for fifth place individually with a 216 (E) total. It is the best finish of his career and his second career top-10 finish.

He was one of two Wildcats to finish in the top 10, as junior Juan Pablo Hernandez finished in a tie for ninth place with a two-over 218 total. Hernandez posted an even-par 72 to collect the second top-10 finish of his career.

As a team, the Wildcats posted a final-round 299 (+11) to finish the 54-hole event in a tie for fourth place with a 885 (+21) tally. It marks Arizona's first top-five team finish in fall competition since 2008. UNLV topped the 16-team with an 867 (+3) total, four shots ahead of host New Mexico and 16 ahead of San Diego State.

BYU's Zachary Blair claimed individual medalist honors. His final round 70 led to a seven-under 209 total.

## Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate (7th of 12)

Oct. 3-4, 2011 . . . . . Vestavia Hills, Ala.

Arizona finished in seventh place at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate in Vestavia Hills, Ala. Wildcat junior Juan Pablo Hernandez continued his strong play to open the season in carding a final-round 68 (-2) to finish the 54-hole event in a tie for sixth place at even-par 210.

The 210 aggregate total and sixth-place finish are career bests for the native of Mexico City, Mexico. In two events this season (six rounds), Hernandez has a pair of top-10 finishes to his credit and four rounds at par or better, including two rounds in the 60s.

As a team, Arizona was unable to move up from the seventh slot in which it began the round, posting a 295 (+15) tally and finishing with an 874 (+34) total.

Texas won the 12-team event with an 836 (-4) tally. Clemson (856) and host Alabama (856) tied for runner-up honors. Clemson's Corbin Mills shot a final-round 67 to claim individual medalist honors at nine-under 201.

UA's Chris Capo posted a 74 to finish in a tie for 18th place at eight-over 218. It marked the first career top-20 finish for the sophomore from Woodland Hills, Calif.

## Lone Star Invitational (6th of 15)

Oct. 16-18, 2011 . . . . . San Antonio, Texas

Arizona battled high winds that swept through Texas Tuesday - sustained winds near 30 miles per hour with gusts nearing 40 - and posted a 311 (+23) total over the final round en route to a 16-over 880 finish, which was good for sixth place in the field of 15. All told, teams were an average of 22 strokes above par during the final round.

New Mexico won the 54-hole event with a three-under 861 tally, eight shots ahead of Texas A&M. North Texas (869), Texas State (870) and Baylor (872) rounded out the top-five places.

Rice's Jeff Wibawa captured individual medalist honors, as his final round 72 (E) moved him from fifth to first over the final 18 holes. His 208 (-7) total was led the 84-man field by a stroke.

Arizona sophomore Erik Oja earned his second top-10 finish of the season with a tie for seventh place. The Sandviken, Sweden, native's even-par 216 led to his third career top-10 effort.

Junior Juan Pablo Hernandez posted a tie for 12th place after carding a two-over 218 total. His final-round 76 was Arizona's low round of the day. Hernandez has a pair of top-10 and a top-20 finish in three starts this fall.

## Gifford Collegiate Championship (7th of 11)

Oct. 31-Nov. 2, 2011 . . . . . San Martin, Calif.

Arizona posted a 373 (+18) tally in the final round and finished with a three-round total of 1,112 (+47) to finish seventh in the 11-team field.

USC won the 54-hole, play-six, count-five format with an eight-under 1,057 tally, four shots ahead of host UCLA.

USC's Steve Lim earned individual medalist honors, as his final-round 69 (-2) moved him to the top of the leader board. His 202 (-11) total led the 72-man field by a stroke.

The Wildcats were led by junior Trent Redfern, who posted the low round and low tournament total of his career in earning the first top-10 finish of his career. A native of Austin, Texas, Redfern tied for seventh place individually with a one-over 214 total and was boosted by his second-round 68.

Fellow junior Juan Pablo Hernandez tied for 25th place, rebounding nicely from a first-round 80, to finish with a nine-over 222 total.

## Arizona Invitational (1st of 12)

Jan. 30-31, 2012 . . . . . Tucson, Ariz.

The UA men held on to a slim lead heading into the final round of the Arizona Intercollegiate and made it hold up in winning by one stroke over California at Arizona National Golf Club. Arizona (835/-17), California (836/-16), and third-place New Mexico (850/-2) were the only teams in the field of 12 to finish under par.

In the event's 32-year history, Arizona has won the Arizona Intercollegiate six times ('88, '91, '96, 2003, '04, and '12). It also is the sixth time in Arizona Intercollegiate history that the team title has been decided by one stroke ('84, '87, '94, 2002, '10, '12). In a reversal of today's result, California topped Arizona 823-824 in 2010, the last time the tournament saw a one-stroke margin of victory.

New Mexico's John Catlin battled from third place in the first round to finish with a final score of 203 (-10). Catlin held off Arizona junior Juan Pablo Hernandez by three strokes to take individual medalist honors.

Joining Hernandez in the top five was his UA teammate and freshman Tucker Wadkins, who tied for third place shooting a five-under 208. Along with Hernandez and Wadkins, sophomores Chris Capo and Erik Oja finished in the top-10, both shooting an identical 212 (-1) totals.

## John Burns Intercollegiate (10th of 18)

Feb. 15-17, 2012 . . . . . Kahuku, O'ahu, Hawaii

Carding a third-round 306 (+18), the Wildcats held onto 10th place at the John A. Burns Intercollegiate, competed at the Arnold Palmer Course at Turtle Bay Resort.

California remained in the top spot to win the tournament for the second consecutive year with a final result of seventeen under par. UA finished the tournament with a final tally of 887 (+23), and was able to hold onto its placement with the performances of junior Juan Pablo Hernandez and freshman Tucker Wadkins. Both posted final-round 75s (+3). Hernandez finished in a tie for 31st place and Wadkins finished in a tie for 41st.

Duke's Julian Suri took the individual title after shooting a 70 (-2) to finish the tournament at 11-under 205.

## Wyoming Desert Intercollegiate (11th of 24)

Feb. 25-26, 2012 . . . . . Palm Desert, Calif.

With a pair of scores under 300, Arizona finished the final two rounds of the Wyoming Desert Intercollegiate and landed in eleventh place (878/+14) in Palm Desert, Calif.

With three players in the top five, UNLV won the team race with a final score of 844. UNLV's Kevin Penner took first with a final score of 209 (-7). Teammate Derek Ernst finished in a tie for second place along with Baylor's Joakim Mikkelsen, both finishing with a score of 210 (-6).

For Arizona, junior Juan Pablo Hernandez was the only Wildcat to finish at even par for the tournament with a final score of 216 (E) to tie for 21st place. Behind Hernandez was freshman Brenden Redfern, who finished in a tie for 27th place with a one-over 217.

# 2011-12 Arizona Men's Golf Tournament Summaries

## Fresno State Lexus Classic (5th of 16)

March 5-6, 2012 ..... Fresno, Calif.

The Wildcats carded a final-round 382 and finished the three-round event with a 1,100 (+20) total, finishing in fifth place in the 16-team field. It was Arizona's second top-five finish this season.

Oregon State (1,087) won the event by six strokes over Washington State (1,093). San Diego (1,096) and Pacific (1,099) rounded out the top-four places. The Fresno State Lexus Classic was a six-play, five-count tournament contested at Fort Washington Country Club.

San Diego's Alex Ching captured individual medalist honors with a seven-under 209 total.

Leading the way for the Wildcats was Juan Pablo Hernandez, who finished in seventh place with an even-par 216 tally. It was the fourth top-10 finish of the season for the junior from Mexico City, Mexico. Also finishing in the top 20 was classmate Brenden Redfern, who tied for 14th place at three-over 219.

## National Invitational Tournament (6th of 12)

March 16-17, 2012 ..... Tucson, Ariz.

UA carded a 295 in the final round of the National Invitational Tournament to remain in sixth place with a final total of 882.

San Diego State finished with a final of 859 (-5) for the team win. UNLV was one stroke behind San Diego State, finishing with an 860 (-4) for second place, while SMU rounded out the top three with a final of 863 (-1).

In the individual race, San Diego State's J.J. Spaun remained in first place after carding a final round of 68 for a total of 201 (-15).

For the Wildcats, sophomore Erik Oja led the squad, finishing the final round in a four-way tie for eighth place with a third-round 73 for a final of 216 (E). Junior Juan Pablo Hernandez finished two strokes behind Oja with a 218 (+2) for a tie for 16th, along with senior Philip Bagdade, who competed in the event as an individual. Freshman Alex McMahon finished one stroke behind Hernandez and Bagdade with a final total of 219 (+3) to tie for 20th place.

## Barona Collegiate Cup (11th of 16)

March 22-23, 2012 ..... San Diego, Calif.

Arizona's Erik Oja finished in a tie for 14th place individually at the Barona Collegiate Cup.

Oja, a sophomore from Sandviken, Sweden, carded a final-round 69 (-3) en route to a five-under 211 total and a tie for 14th place. It was his second consecutive top-20 finish and his fifth - including four top-10 efforts - this season. Additionally, the 211 total marked a season low for Oja in both aggregate and total in relation to par.

With two rounds in the 60s in this event, Oja now has the team lead in that category with seven. In six spring events, his scoring average is 72.94 strokes per round.

Oja helped Arizona finish in 11th place in the 54-hole event with a 1,094 (+14) total. His 69 equaled Arizona's low round of the tournament and was one of eight sub-par rounds registered by the Wildcats in the tournament.

Host San Diego State won the event with a 1,051 (-29) total, finishing two shots ahead of USC. SDSU's J.J. Spaun garnered individual medalist honors with a 14-under 202 tally.

In addition to Oja, Arizona's Philip Bagdade finished at level-par 216 and tied for 31st place.

## ASU/Thunderbird Invitational (11th of 16)

April 6-7, 2012 ..... Tempe, Ariz.

Arizona posted a final-round 295 (+11) to finish the 54-hole event with an 882 (+30) total in the 17-team event.

California (835/-17) topped the field by eight strokes, finishing ahead of San Diego State (843) and New Mexico (843). UNLV's Derek Ernst earned individual medalist honors after posting a nine-under 204 total.

Arizona was led by sophomore Erik Oja, who tied for 16th place at two-under 211. The native of Sandviken, Sweden, who has been the Wildcats' top finisher in the last three events, was the only Wildcat to post a score under par (2) in the three rounds played. He's been under par in five of his last eight rounds played.

Junior Juan Pablo Hernandez carded a final-round 73 (+2) - his low

round of the tournament - and finished in a tie for 48th place at 222 (+9). Freshman Alex McMahon, competing in this event as an individual, shot a final-round 74 to finish in a tie for 56th place at 11-over 224.

## Wyoming Cowboy Classic (T6th of 23)

April 9-10, 2012 ..... Scottsdale, Ariz.

Arizona finished the third round of the 10th Annual Wyoming Cowboy Classic presented by Cleveland Golf/Srixon in a three-way tie for sixth place with Kansas and Wichita State with a final score of 836 (-4).

In the team race, Kansas State carded a 281 to claim first place with a final total of 826 (-14). With a third-round score of 276, Colorado finished in second place with a total of 828 (-12).

Individually, Kansas State's Ben Juffer and Colorado State's Mike Wuertz finished at 12-under (198), with Juffer taking the victory by playoff.

For Arizona, freshman Brenden Redfern, who competed as an individual, carded a career-low 64 (-6) in the third round to finish in seventh place (203/-7). The event marks Redfern's first career top-10 finish, and the first event where he has finished under par.

Also in the top-20, freshman Tucker Wadkins recorded his best finish since the Arizona Intercollegiate (Jan. 30-31) with a final of 206 (-4) for a tie for eleventh place. Wadkins' first-round score of 67 marks a new career low.

Junior Juan Pablo Hernandez finished in a tie for 17th with a final total of 208 (-2). Hernandez's under-par finish was his first since the Arizona Intercollegiate. Junior Trent Redfern improved five places to finish in a tie for 24th with a final of 209 (-1). This marks the first time this season that Redfern has finished an event below par, and his best finish since the Fresno State Lexus Classic (March 5-6). Redfern's first-round score of 67 marked a season low.

## 2012 Pac-12 Championships (10th of 12)

April 27-29, 2012 ..... Corvallis, Ore.

Arizona finished the final round of the 2012 Pac-12 Golf Championships with a 369 (+9) score, and a final total of 1,493 (+53), which was good for tenth place.

Both California and Oregon finished the event with final totals of 1428 (-12), and after a two-hole playoff, the Bears outlasted the Ducks to take the Pac-12 conference crown. Individually, Stanford's Andrew Yun, with three rounds in the 60s, took first place with a final of 257 (-13).

The Wildcat squad was paced by the performance of sophomore Erik Oja, who finished even on the day for another top-20 finish at 16th place with a final total of 288 (E). Freshman Tucker Wadkins finished in a tie for 32nd place with a final of 295 (+7). Junior Juan Pablo Hernandez finished with a final total of 301 (+13) for a tie for 47th place.

## 2012 NCAA Southwest Regional (T9th of 14)

May 17-19, 2012 ..... Norman, Okla.

Arizona finished in a tie for ninth place at the 2012 NCAA Southwest Regional in Norman, Okla. The Wildcats, seeded 11th in the field, shot a final-round 302 (+14) total to tie San Diego for ninth place in the 14-team field with a 902 (+38) total.

Washington carded a five-over-par 293 to win the regional with an 860 (-4) total, four strokes ahead of second-place Texas. UW's Chris Williams shot a final-round 68 to come from behind and claim individual medalist honors with a 209 (-7) total.

Arizona was led Saturday by junior Juan Pablo Hernandez, who tallied a one-over 73 and finished in a tie for 35th place at 226 (+10). Hernandez's 73 was Arizona's low round of the day and moved him 15 spots up the leaderboard.

Sophomore Erik Oja was the Wildcats' top finisher, tying for 24th place at six-over 222. He has been Arizona's top finisher in five of UA's last six events. He finished two strokes ahead of teammate Tucker Wadkins, who tied for 31st place at eight-over 224.

The day put a cap on the 39-year coaching career of Rick LaRose, including the last 34 seasons as Arizona's golf coach, who had announced April 24 that he was retiring at season's end.
