The Game: The Arizona Wildcats and the New Mexico Lobos will face off in Albuquerque, N.M. Tip-off is set for 2 p.m. MT.

The Coverage: Arizona women's basketball games can be heard live on KTUC AM 1400. All broadcasts will start 15 minutes prior to tip-off for the pregame show. Derrick Palmer (play-by-play) and Lisa Salgado (color) will call the action this season.

Scouting the Wildcats: Under fifth-year head coach Niya Butts, Arizona returns three starters and welcomes six newcomers, including three true freshmen, for the 2012-13 season. Senior guard Davellyn Whyte, a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree and preseason All-Pac-12 pick, is averaging 15.8 points and 5.4 rebounds in seven games.

Juniors Kama Griffitts and Alli Gloyd are stepping up as UA's top contributors, averaging 10.3 and 10.9 ppg, respectively. Griffitts is also averaging 5.5 rebounds and 2.1 steals.

Scouting the Lobos: Under second-year head coach Yvonne Sanchez, the Lobos have started the season on a 7-2 mark, led by guard Caroline Durbin's 15.0 ppg in 2011-12.

Durbin has continued to impress as she leads the team with 12.4 ppg in New Mexico's first nine games. Forward Deeva Vaughn has also emerged as one of the Lobos' top scorers, averaging 10.2 ppg. Forward Jourdan Erskine is leading the team in rebounds at 6.6 rpg.

As a team, the Lobos are shooting an average of 42.2 percent from the field and 34.3 percent from the three-point line.

They are outrebounding their opponents, averaging 42.4 rpg to their opponents' 35.2.

Last time out: Arizona fell in its first road game to Long Beach State, 71-61. The Wildcats led by 14 in the first half, but were outrebounded, 43-27.

Senior Davellyn Whyte led the team with 17 points and eight steals. Junior Erica Barnes added 11 points and a team-high six rebounds.

Forcing Turnovers: As a team, Arizona is forcing an average of 22.3 turnovers in seven games. It is a team goal to force at least 25 turnovers each game.

Senior Leadership: Arizona senior Davellyn Whyte has scored double-digits in all eight games this season, scoring 16 at CSU Bakersfield (in 20 minutes), 21 at UNLV, 16 versus CSU Northridge, 12 vs. BYU, 19 vs. UTEP, 11 vs. Texas Southern, 14 at North Texas and 17 at Long Beach State. She has led the team in scoring in five out of eight games and her performance at the Junkanoo Jam earned her a spot on the All-Tournament Team.

Last Meeting: New Mexico and Arizona have met 17 times in a history dating back to 1973, with the Wildcats holding a 12-9 advantage. UA has won the last two matchups and defeated the Lobos, 59-50 in 2011 at McKale Center. Davellyn Whyte had 27 points and 12 rebounds in the game.

Welcome Back: Arizona returns three starters and two additional letterwinners to the 2012-13 roster. Davellyn Whyte, Erica Barnes and Candice Warthen all return as starters, while Layana White and Cheylene Harper return as letterwinners. Cheshi Poston returns after she was ruled ineligible in 2011 and Kama Griffiths makes her debut after redshirting last year.

Fresh Faces: Fifth-year head coach Niya Butts welcomes six new players to the court for the 2012-13 season. Shereen Sutherland, Keyahndra Cannon and Nyre Harris are true freshman, while Carissa Crutchfield, Lynette Holmes and Alli Gloyd transferred from other schools.

Preseason Picks: Arizona was picked to finish 12th in the 2012-13 Pac-12 Preseason Poll that was released in late October. For the 12th season in a row, defending champion Stanford was picked to add another crown to its mantle.

Setting the Schedule: In the non-conference season, Arizona will also travel to UNLV, North Texas, Long Beach State and New Mexico University.

In addition, the Wildcats will travel to the Bahamas for the Junkanoo Jam tournament Nov. 21-25, with games versus UTEP on Friday, Nov. 23 and Texas Southern on Saturday, Nov. 24.

Arizona will host Cal State Northridge, BYU, Weber State and Longwood University before opening Pac-12 Conference play versus Washington State in Pullman, Wash. on Friday, Jan. 4.

In the conference schedule, UA will also make trips to Washington (1/6), Utah (1/18), Colorado (1/20), UCLA (1/25), USC (1/27), Stanford (2/8), California (2/10) and Arizona State (2/24). The Wildcats will host Oregon (1/11), Oregon State (1/13), Washington (2/1), Washington State (2/3), Colorado (2/15), Utah (2/17), Arizona State (2/22) and will conclude the season hosting games against USC (3/1) and UCLA (3/3).

In 2012, Stanford, California, BYU and UTEP all advanced to the NCAA Tournament, while UNLV, Oregon State, Washington, Utah, Arizona State, Cal State Northridge and Colorado competed in the WNIT.

Something New: The 2012-13 season will mark the first time Arizona has faced Cal State Bakersfield and Longwood.

Head Coach Niya Butts

Entering her fifth season at the helm of the Wildcat program, women's basketball head coach Niya Butts is more energized and driven than ever to continue to build on the strong tradition of Arizona women's basketball and to take the program to new heights. With a talented class of younger players and an experienced and motivated group of veterans, the 2011-12 season is poised to be a successful stop on the road to greatness.

One of the most sought after young coaches in the country, Arizona named Butts its new women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2008, ushering in a new era of Wildcat women's basketball. She is the eighth head coach in the program's history and is the first African American female head coach at the University of Arizona.

In just three seasons, Butts has achieved a number of milestones early on in her head coaching career. The 2010-11 slate was the best year yet. The Wildcats made their first postseason appearance since the 2004-05 season and their first appearance in the Women's NIT since the 2000-01 season. Arizona won eight of its last 11 contests. Also in 2010-11, the Wildcats got a win against the Arizona State Sun Devils for the first time since Jan. 26, 2005.

The Wildcats' 10-8 conference record in 2010-11 is their best since the 2004-05 campaign and their 21 wins overall is the most since the 2003-04 season. The 2010-11 season marks the highest finish in the Pac-10 for Arizona - fourth - since tying for the Pac-10 regular-season crown in 2004.

Senior forward Ify Ibekwe and sophomore guard Davellyn Whyte both earned 2011 All-Pac-10 accolades. Ibekwe was named the 2011 Pac-10 Defensive Player of the Year and earned a spot on the Pac-10 All-Defensive Team. Freshman forward Erica Barnes was named honorable mention All-Pac-10 Freshman Team. In the awards given out by the Pac-10 media, Ibekwe was named All-Pac-10 and a member of the All-Pac-10 Defensive Team. Senior forward Soana Lucet was also named to the 2011 Pac-10 All-Tournament Team by members of the media. Ibekwe capped the season off with her honorable mention Associated Press All-America honor.

Overall, the Wildcats improved from 12 wins in 2008-09, to 14 wins in 2009-10, to 21 wins in 2010-11. In Pac-10 play, Arizona improved from four wins in 2008-09, to six wins in 2009-10, to 10 wins in 2010-11.

During the 2009-10 campaign, the Wildcats posted their highest win total in five seasons while also achieving the most Pac-10 wins for the program in that same span. In their historic win over Oregon on Jan. 16, Arizona scored a school-record 119 points while then-freshman Whyte scored a single-game record 39 points. The Cats won the Iona College Tip-Off Tournament to start the season and wrapped up by advancing to the Pac-10 Tournament Quarterfinals for the second-straight season.

Whyte and then-junior Ibekwe were named first-team All-Pac-10 while Whyte was chosen as the Pac-10 Freshman of the Year and Ibekwe was named to the all-defensive team. Whyte was the top vote-getter on the five-player Pac-10 All-Freshman Team. Ibekwe repeated both her All-Pac-10 and All-Defensive Team awards after earning the same honors during her sophomore season.

In 2008-09, Butts led the Wildcats to a Bank of Hawaii Classic Tournament championship in the first weekend of her career, including wins over Hawai'i and Loyola Marymount, and then mentored the Wildcats to the second round of the Pac-10 Tournament, propelled by a win over Washington State. The conference portion of the slate included wins over Oregon and USC and a sweep of Washington.

Then a sophomore, Ibekwe was named to the Associated Press All-America honorable mention team. Ibekwe, a first-team All-Pac-10 selection and first-team All-Pac-10 Defensive Team honoree, led Arizona in scoring, rebounding, steals, blocked shots, free throws, field goals and double-doubles during the 2008-09 slate. She finished the season with 336 rebounds, coming up three shy of the program's single-season record set in the 2003-04 season. Her 16 double-doubles were also second all-time for a single-season behind the 21 posted in the 2002-03 campaign.

Ibekwe led the Pac-10 and finished sixth in the NCAA in rebounds per game at 11.6. She was also third in the Pac-10 in scoring at 15.7 points per game while also ending up second in blocked shots (1.8) and 4th in steals (2.1).

Butts came to Tucson from the University of Kentucky where she spent five seasons as an assistant coach. In her final season in Lexington, she served as Kentucky's associate head coach, and was the program's recruiting coordinator for three seasons. While at UK, Butts secured two top-10 recruiting classes, solidifying her status as one of the best young coaching talents in the nation.

Butts is no stranger to rebuilding programs. During her tenure at Kentucky, Butts helped coach the Wildcats to an 88-72 record (.550) over five seasons, with a trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2005-06 and three WNIT appearances. In her final season, Butts helped lead Kentucky to a 17-16 overall record, an 8-6 mark in the SEC for a fourth-place finish, and a WNIT quarterfinal appearance.

Before her stint at Kentucky, Butts spent the 2002-03 season as an assistant coach at Michigan State. Butts helped coach MSU to a 17-12 overall record that season and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament, the Spartans' first since 1997. Prior to Michigan State, Butts spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, Tenn., leading the Golden Eaglettes to two Ohio Valley Conference regular-season championships in both 2001 and 2002.

Butts played collegiately at the University of Tennessee for Pat Summitt, where she was a four-year letter winner and a member of two NCAA Championship teams (1997, 1998). The Lady Vols won three SEC titles (1998, 1999, 2000) during her tenure, and she was voted the SEC's Defensive Player of the Year in 1997. She also won the Lady Vols' Unsung Hero Award that season.

Butts was a three-time Academic All-SEC selection (1998, 1999, 2000) and earned Tennessee's Academic Achiever of the Week four times. She played in 111 career games at UT and graduated in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in social work and a minor in psychology. She received a master's degree in education from Tennessee Tech in 2002.

Butts, 34, is a native of Americus, Ga. She is a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated.
