**The Game:** The Arizona Wildcats and the Oregon Ducks will open the Pac-10 portion of the 2010-11 season with a contest at McKale Center on Fri., Dec. 31. Tip-off is scheduled for 3 p.m. MT. The game will be both teams' first test at Pac-10 play.

**The Coverage:** All Wildcat games can be heard live on KTUC AM 1400. All broadcasts will start 15 minutes prior to tip-off for the pre-game show. Entering their third season calling Arizona Wildcat women's basketball games will be Derrick Palmer (play-by-play) and Alysiah Bond (color). Live video and stats are available at ArizonaWildcats.com.

**The Series:** The Arizona Wildcats and the Oregon Ducks will meet for the 52nd time on Friday. The Ducks lead the series 29-22 over the Wildcats. Last season, the two teams split the home and home series with Arizona winning 119-112 in overtime at McKale on Jan. 16 and the Ducks winning 92-74 on Feb. 11 at McArthur Court. Since the 2008 season, Arizona and Oregon have split the last six games evenly at 3-3.

**Scouting the Wildcats:** The Arizona Wildcats are 9-2 overall and 5-0 at home with the non-conference season coming to an end. The Wildcats have three players averaging double-digit points in sophomore guard Davellyn Whyte (15.5), senior forward Ify Ibekwe (15.1) and senior forward Soana Lucet (13.5). Ibekwe leads Arizona at the glass with 10.0 rebounds per game and junior guard Shanita Arnold dishes out a Pac-10 leading 6.1 assists per game.

Currently, Wildcat players lead the Pac-10 in rebounds (Ibekwe, 100, 10.0 pg), assists (Arnold, 67, 6.1 pg) and defensive rebounds (Ibekwe, 66, 6.6 pg). Additionally, the squad leads the Pac-10 in defensive rebounds (328, 29.8 pg).

**Scouting the Ducks:** The Oregon Ducks are 9-2 overall and 5-0 on the road to start the season. They have picked up wins on the home courts of Long Beach State, Portland, Boise State, St. Mary's (Calif.) and Santa Clara. Amanda Johnson leads the Ducks with 19.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per game. Nia Jackson chips in with 15.5 points per game.

The Ducks currently lead the Pac-10 in scoring offense (88.5 ppg), scoring margin (+18.7), rebounding offense (49.1 pg), assists (18.0 pg), steals (15.1 pg), turnover margin (+10.5), offensive rebounds (20.9 pg) and three-point field goals made (7.8 pg).

Individually, Amanda Johnson leads the league with 19.9 points per game, Victoria Kenyon leads in three-point field goal percentage with .458 and Nia Jackson leads in assist/turnover ratio with 2.0.

**Last Time Out:** The Wildcats moved to 9-2 with a 79-32 win over the Iona Gaels. Four Wildcats scored in double digits in Tuesday's win over the Gaels: Ibekwe 14, senior forward Soana Lucet 11, Whyte 11 and freshman forward Erica Barnes 10. Junior guard Shanita Arnold also dished out nine assists, matching her career best.

**A Look Ahead:** Arizona is three games into a five-game homestand which will continue with the Oregon Ducks on Dec. 31 and the Oregon State Beavers on Jan. 2. The homestand started with a win over New Mexico State on Dec. 19, a win over North Texas on Dec. 21 and a win over Iona on Dec. 28.

**In Reserve:** Arizona's main contributors off the bench are coming from their two youngest players. Freshman Erica Barnes is averaging 8.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in 18.9 minutes. Freshman Candice Warthen is averaging 7.5 points and 3.6 rebounds per game in 20.4 minutes.

**Iffy on Fire:** Senior forward Iffy Ibekwe is making the most of her final season with the Wildcats. In 10 games played, she's averaging 15.1 points and 10.0 rebounds per game with seven games in double-digit scoring. In her last eight outings, she's averaged 17.6 points per game and scored in double digits in all but one of those contests.

**Hey Arnold!:** Junior guard Shanita Arnold is making a splash in her first season with the Wildcats. Starting all 11 games thus far, she's played a team leading 30.7 minutes per game. She averages a Pac-10 leading 6.1 assists per game with 67 total in 11 contests. She's dished out at least six assists in six games and handed out nine assists in three games.

**History in the Making:** For the first time since the 2004-05 season, Arizona is 9-2 to start the season. For the first time since the 2001-02 season, the Wildcat women's basketball team was 3-0 to start the season after a 72-70 win at Ole Miss. For the first time since the 1999-2000 season, the Wildcats opened the season with four-straight victories.

**Mirror Image:** Arizona's overtime road win at Wichita State, 81-72, was nearly identical in stature to the start of the 2009-10 season. Arizona picked up a victory in the 2009-10 season opener at Iona College, 77-70, also in overtime.

**Butts' First:** In each of her seasons at the helm of the Arizona program, third-year head coach Niya Butts' first win of each season has come in overtime: at Wichita State, 81-72, 11/12/10; at Iona, 77-70, 11/14/09; vs. Loyola Marymount, 93-88, 11/15/08.

*Junior Shanita Arnold*

In the season opener vs Wichita State, she was one of four players to score in double digits (16) ... Also tallied seven assists and four steals in the Wildcats' 81-72 win at Wichita ... Picked up nine assists, four rebounds and a steal in the 71-49 win over Northern Arizona ... Matched her season best with nine assists in UA's road win at Ole Miss, 72-70 ... Also grabbed three steals and scored five points ... Dished out four more assists in the 93-54 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff ... Against No. 8/8 Texas A&M, Arnold was one of five Wildcats to score in double digits with her 15 points ... She also passed out five assists ... In the win over Bradley, she has a balance game with eight points and six rebounds ... She recorded three points and four assists at Nevada ... In the win at New Mexico, she dishes out five assists and grabbed three steals ... Arnold handed out seven assists and grabbed three rebounds in the win over New Mexico State... *Freshman Erica Barnes*

Recorded her first collegiate double-double in the OT win at Wichita State ... Tallied 16 points and 14 rebounds, including 10 on defense ... Also dished out two assists and grabbed one steal ... Against Northern Arizona, she scored seven points and grabbed eight rebounds in the 71-49 victory ... Only logged one minute of play at Ole Miss and didn't record any stats ... Scored six points and grabbed six rebounds against UAPB ... Also blocked one shot and logged a steal ... In 19 minutes of play vs. No. 8/8 Texas A&M, she scored four points and grabbed four rebounds ... Barnes recorded her second double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Bradley ... Scored eight points and pulled down seven rebounds in the loss to Nevada ... Recorded her third double-double of the season with 10 points and 12 boards in the win at New Mexico ... Barnes scored 12 points and grabbed four rebounds in the win over New Mexico State ... *Junior Taylor Dalrymple*

Did not see any action against Wichita State ... Made her season debut in the 71-49 win over Northern Arizona, scoring seven points and grabbing four rebounds ... #### *Junior Brooke Jackson*

Put her shooting skills to good use at Wichita State, chipping in with 15 points, five rebounds and two steals in the 81-72 OT win ... Racked up five rebounds and four points in the 71-49 win over Northern Arizona ... At Ole Miss, scored two points, grabbed four points and logged an assist and a blocked shot ... Racked up 13 points and dished out five assists in the 93-54 win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff ... She logged five points and four boards in the loss to No. 8/8 Texas A&M ... Scored nine points and grabbed four rebounds and three steals in Arizona's win over Northern Arizona ... Scored in double digits again at Ole Miss, recording 17 points, five rebounds and three assists ... For the second-straight game, scored in double digits with 14 points ... Also recorded three rebounds, dished out five assists and blocked two shots ... She led the Wildcats in scoring with 16 points in the loss to No. 8/8 Texas A&M ... Also grabbed four boards and passed out four assists ... Whyte racked up 12 points and four steals in the win over Bradley ... Picked up 16 points, two rebounds and four steals in the loss at Nevada ... In the win at New Mexico, she scored a team-leading 24 points, including five threes in the final 10 minutes of play ... grabbed five rebounds and five steals ... In just 17 minutes of play in the win over Iona, scored 10 points and grabbed four rebounds while snagging two steals ...

**Preseason Picks:** Arizona was picked to finish seventh in the Pac-10 Preseason Poll. Ten-time defending champion Stanford was picked to add another crown to its mantle.

In a vote by the league media, the Wildcats were picked to finish sixth in the Pac-10 Conference this season, it was announced in the preseason poll. Additionally, senior forward Ify Ibekwe was named preseason All-Pac-10 by the league's media members.

**Welcome Back:** Arizona Wildcat women's basketball returns four starters and three additional letterwinners for the 2010-11 season. A strong senior class includes All-Pac-10 honoree Ify Ibekwe, Soana Lucet and Amanda Pierson. Now a sophomore, Davellyn Whyte returns as the defending Pac-10 Freshman of the Year. Sharp-shooter junior Brooke Jackson, who started 20 games in 2009-10, is also back to bolster the Wildcat offense.

## Head Coach Niya Butts

Entering her third season at the helm of the Wildcat program, women's basketball head coach Niya Butts is more energized and driven than ever to continue to build on the strong tradition of Arizona women's basketball and to take the program to new heights. With a talented class of younger players and an experienced and motivated group of veterans, the 2010-11 season is poised to be a successful stop on the road to greatness.

One of the most sought after young coaches in the country, Arizona named Butts its new women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2008, ushering in a new era of Wildcat women's basketball. She is the eighth head coach in the program's history and is the first African American female head coach at the University of Arizona.

In just two seasons, Butts has achieved a number of milestones early on in her head coaching career. During the 2009-10 campaign, the Wildcats posted their highest win total in five seasons while also achieving the most Pac-10 wins for the program in that same span. In their historic win over Oregon on Jan. 16, Arizona scored a school-record 119 points while then-freshman guard Davellyn Whyte scored a single-game record 39 points. The Cats won the Iona College Tip-Off Tournament to start the season and wrapped up by advancing to the Pac-10 Tournament Quarterfinals for the second-straight season.

Whyte and then-junior forward Ify Ibekwe were named first-team All-Pac-10 while Whyte was chosen as the Pac-10 Freshman of the Year and Ibekwe was named to the all-defensive team. Whyte was the top vote-getter on the five-player Pac-10 All-Freshman Team. Ibekwe repeated both her All-Pac-10 and All-Defensive Team awards after earning the same honors during her sophomore season.

In 2008-09, Butts led the Wildcats to a Bank of Hawaii Classic Tournament championship in the first weekend of her career, including wins over Hawai'i and Loyola Marymount, and then mentored the Wildcats to the second round of the Pac-10 Tournament, propelled by a win over Washington State. The conference portion of the slate included wins over Oregon and USC and a sweep of Washington.

Then a sophomore, Ibekwe was named to the Associated Press All-America honorable mention team. Ibekwe, a first-team All-Pac-10 selection and first-team All-Pac-10 Defensive Team honoree, led Arizona in scoring, rebounding, steals, blocked shots, free throws, field goals and double-doubles during the 2008-09 slate. She finished the season with 336 rebounds, coming up three shy of the program's single-season record set in the 2003-04 season. Her 16 double-doubles were also second all-time for a single-season behind the 21 posted in the 2002-03 campaign.

Ibekwe led the Pac-10 and finished sixth in the NCAA in rebounds per game at 11.6. She was also third in the Pac-10 in scoring at 15.7 points per game while also ending up second in blocked shots (1.8) and 4th in steals (2.1).

Butts came to Tucson from the University of Kentucky where she spent five seasons as an assistant coach. In her final season in Lexington, she served as Kentucky's associate head coach, and was the program's recruiting coordinator for three seasons. While at UK, Butts secured two top-10 recruiting classes, solidifying her status as one of the best young coaching talents in the nation.

Butts is no stranger to rebuilding programs. During her tenure at Kentucky, Butts helped coach the Wildcats to an 88-72 record (.550) over five seasons, with a trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2005-06 and three WNIT appearances. In her final season, Butts helped lead Kentucky to a 17-16 overall record, an 8-6 mark in the SEC for a fourth-place finish, and a WNIT quarterfinal appearance.

Before her stint at Kentucky, Butts spent the 2002-03 season as an assistant coach at Michigan State. Butts helped coach MSU to a 17-12 overall record that season and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament, the Spartans' first since 1997. Prior to Michigan State, Butts spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, Tenn., leading the Golden Eaglettes to two Ohio Valley Conference regular-season championships in both 2001 and 2002.

Butts played collegiately at the University of Tennessee for Pat Summitt, where she was a four-year letter winner and a member of two NCAA Championship teams (1997, 1998). The Lady Vols won three SEC titles (1998, 1999, 2000) during her tenure, and she was voted the SEC's Defensive Player of the Year in 1997. She also won the Lady Vols' Unsung Hero Award that season.

Butts was a three-time Academic All-SEC selection (1998, 1999, 2000) and earned Tennessee's Academic Achiever of the Week four times. She played in 111 career games at UT and graduated in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in social work and a minor in psychology. She received a master's degree in education from Tennessee Tech in 2002. Butts, 32, is a native of Americus, Ga.
