### Game 25: #25 Arizona State (19-6, 11-2) at Arizona (10-14, 3-10) Arizona Rivals Square Off For Second Time This Season

**Tip Off Time:** Arizona completes its trip through Los Angeles on Sunday, February 15 as the Wildcats take on USC in a Pink Zone game. The Galen Center will also be the host site of the 2009 Pac-10 Tournament, running March 12-15.

**Catch the Action:** Entering his second season calling Arizona women's basketball games will be Derrick Palmer. He will be joined by Alysiah Bond, the Arizona women's basketball director of operations and former collegiate point guard at The Ohio State University. Wildcat games can be heard live on KTUC AM 1400. All broadcasts will start 30 minutes prior to tip-off for the pre-game show. **UCLA Recap:** Arizona followed up one of its best performances of the season with a near carbon copy of one of its most disappointing as UCLA claimed a 58-39 win over the Wildcats. Arizona shot a season-low 22 percent from the field, connected on just three second half field goals and were beaten at a 49-32 clip on the boards. Ify Ibekwe tallied her 12th double-double of the season, claiming team-highs of 12 points and 10 rebounds to go along with five steals and two blocked shots. Courtney Clements also chipped in with 10 points, all coming in the first half. Erica Tukiainen led UCLA with 21 points on 9-of-12 shooting.

#### Head Coach Niya Butts:

Not only has the Arizona playing roster seen its share of turnover, but the coaching staff is also entirely new for the 2008-09 season. On April 3, 2008, Niya Butts was named the 8th coach in the history of Arizona women's basketball. Butts comes to Tucson after spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Kentucky. During her time with the Wildcats, she helped guide the team to a 88-72 record (.550) that included three WNIT appearances and a berth in the 2006 NCAA Tournament. Prior to her time in Lexington, Butts was an assistant coach at Michigan State during the 2002-03 season. That year, the Spartans made their first NCAA appearance in six seasons after posting an overall record of 17-12. She began her coaching career at Tennessee Tech, leading the Golden Eaglettes to back-to-back Ohio Valley Conference regular season titles in 2001 and 2002.

Butts is one of many head coaches in the NCAA ranks who played for the legendary Pat Summitt at the University of Tennessee, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in social work and a minor in psychology. A four-year letterwinner with the Lady Vols, Butts was a two-time NCAA champion (1997, 1998), three-time winner of the SEC championship (1998, 1999, 2000) and was chosen the SEC Defensive Player of the Year after her 1997 freshman campaign. She also excelled in the classroom and was three times named an Academic All-SEC selection (1998, 1999, 2000).

### What Others Know About Niya:

Several prominent figures in the women's basketball scene weighed in following the hiring of Niya Butts to her Arizona post and provided their thoughts on her exploits and abilities.

#### **Pat Summitt, University of Tennessee Head Coach**

"Niya Butts is one of the bright young coaches in the women's collegiate game. I see this as a tremendous opportunity for her to take over the reins of her own program at Arizona and to compete in one of the nation's best conferences – the Pac 10. I see her taking the same qualities I saw in her as a player en route to two NCAA Championships – doing all the little things right – and applying them as a head coach at the University of Arizona."

#### **Lin Dunn, Indiana Fever Head Coach**

"Wow, Arizona sure hit the jackpot. The great thing about Niya is that she has the experience of playing at the championship level and she has great experience coaching in the SEC. That experience will benefit her in building Arizona into a national power. I can't think of a better young coach to take over at Arizona. She is the best of the best."

#### **Matthew Mitchell, University of Kentucky Head Coach**

"I am thrilled for Niya. She is extremely deserving of her position at Arizona. I have worked with no one in my career that has her unique combination of skills to excel as a coach. I have no doubt in my mind that she will turn Arizona into one of the top programs in the country that will last for many years. She helped take Kentucky from the bottom of the SEC to being one of the top-four teams in a short period of time, a testament to her ability to recruit and coach."

#### **Mickie DeMoss, Former Kentucky Head Coach**

"Niya is certainly one of the game's up and coming young coaches in the country. I've known her since 10th grade when I recruited her as a player to Tennessee. I had the opportunity to hire her at Kentucky, and she hit the road running, making a huge difference to that program, notably in recruiting. She is a driven young lady, very mature and very focused. Arizona is very fortunate to have her."

### The Rest of the Staff

**Sue Darling (Arizona '83):** A former player at UA, Darling returns to the Old Pueblo to begin her 24th season in coaching. She has made coaching stops at the Air Force Academy, Northwestern, Dartmouth, Arizona State and with the Seattle Reign of the ABL. Darling was most recently the head girls' basketball coach at Mullen High School in Denver, Colo.

**Brandy Manning (Clark Atlanta '02):** The relative youngster of the staff, Manning is one of the most aggressive recruiters in the women's game today. Serving as the recruiting coordinator for the Wildcats, Manning spent last season at the University of Central Florida. He also has coaching experience from Murray State and the University of Louisville.

**Chance Lindley (Wichita State, '00):** Rounding out the staff is Chance Lindley, who joins the Wildcats after spending the 2007-08 season as the head coach at Barton County Community College. He led the Cougars to a 34-4 record and 4th place finish at the NJCAA championships. Lindley was instrumental in bringing shooting guard Ipek Turkyilmaz to Arizona as she was a key member of the Barton County team last season.

**Do I Know You:** The 2008-09 Arizona Wildcats roster consists of six returning players that will welcome seven newcomers to the fold. Among the returning players are two that earned all-Pac-10 honors and two others that saw considerable minutes in the latter half of the season.

**Who's Back:** Though the Wildcats were forced to say good-bye to leading scorer and 2nd-team all-Pacific-10 selection Ashley Whisonant, the team does return two players who were recognized with postseason accolades. Senior Amina Njonkou was an honorable mention all-conference selection in 2007-08, averaging 13.1 points per game while shooting just under 50 percent from the field and grabbing 7.4 rebounds per contest. Sophomore Ify Ibekwe completes the decorated duo, taking home all-Pac-10 Freshman team honors last season after tallying 10.4 points and a team-leading 8.0 rebounds per game. Fellow frontcourt players Sarah Hays and Beatrice Bofia return for their senior campaigns while sophomore perimeter players Tasha Dickey and Faiha Hill round out the group.

**What's New:** The fresh faces to the Arizona roster have a heavy California flavor as five of the seven players hail from the Golden State. Four of the five will battle for time in the backcourt: Amani Butler, Courtney Clements, Jhakia McDonald and Reiko Thomas. In the frontcourt, 6'5" Malia Nahinu will add size and depth to the frontcourt. On the perimeter, the Wildcats added a junior college transfer in ballhandler Ashley Frazier.

**Series Notes:** Arizona State owns a 43-25 lead in the all-time series between the two in-state rivals. Most recently, the Sun Devils have won seven-straight meetings against the Wildcats, including the last three contests in McKale Center. The last Arizona victory came during the 2004-05 season, a 56-49 triumph in Tucson as Jessica Arnold led the way with a game-high 14 points to go along with five rebounds.

**Last Meeting:** The excitement of Arizona making its 2008-09 regional television debut did not translate into a noteworthy performance as the Wildcats would just assume not think about that game at all. Arizona State jumped out to a 29-12 halftime lead and ran away with a 75-38 triumph. Ify Ibekwe was the only Arizona player in double figures with 13 points as the Wildcats committed 26 turnovers and shot a woeful 26.9 percent from the field.

**Scouting the Sun Devils:** No team in the Pac-10 is hotter than Arizona State, a team in the midst of a 11-game winning streak. Since dropping three-straight games during the holiday period, ASU is unblemished and won the first nine by double digits before earning a pair of three-point wins over USC and UCLA, respectively. Dymond Simon leads the way for the Sun Devils at 14.1 points per game while Briann January contributes 12.6 points, 4.7 assists and a 47.4 three-point field goal percentage.

**Future Cats:** Head coach Niya Butts was happy to announce the signing of the first two players for the 2009 signing class earlier in the season. Senior guard Davellyn White of St. Mary's High School in Phoenix is the first prep player to sign a National Letter of Intent to play for Butts. Whyte, the daughter of former Major League Baseball veteran Devon White, averaged 18 points per game in her junior campaign, leading the Lady Knights to a 19-9 record and the 5A Desert Valley Region championship. She was an all-state selection and was the runner-up in the region player of the year voting. Whyte and the Lady Knights are currently 22-2, have won 18-straight games and are ranked #2 in the state.

Joining Whyte with three years of eligibility remaining is Brooke Jackson, who is currently a freshman at Mesa Community College. A 5'9" shooting guard, Jackson prepped at Mountain View High School and was a two-time East Valley Region Player of the Year and two-time all-state selection. She is the 5A all-time single-season leader in scoring after tallying 849 points as a junior. Jackson also holds state 5A records for free throws made in a game (18) and season (216) as well as career steals (482). A solid outside shooter, Jackson finished her prep career with a 41 percent mark from three-point range. Jackson is averaging 16.9 points per game and is shooting over 47 percent from beyond the arc for the 22-4 Lady Thunderbirds. She was scoring well over 20 points before sustaining a knee injury last month.

**Do the Math:** Though the Wildcats were pleased with their overall effort in the win last Sunday against USC, some of the numbers that showed up in the box score were quite puzzling. Arizona allowed 30 offensive rebounds, committed 28 turnovers, allowed 82 total field goal attempts and hoisted up just 43 total shots. The Cats played five games this season when not allowing 30 total rebounds. Remarkably, the 28-turnover tally was the second of the season for Arizona, both leading to victories (the first coming in the triple-overtime triumph over Loyola Marymount on November 15. The Cats also allowed 82 shots to the Lions in that tournament game in Hawaii. The 43 field goal attempts were the 2nd-fewest of the season and the fewest in an Arizona victory since attempting 49 shots in a 64-57 Pac-10 Tournament victory over Oregon at the end of the 2005-06 season.

**Going the Distance:** With a roster depleted due to injuries, the active and healthy Wildcats have seen their share of minutes this season. Thirty times this season an Arizona player has logged at least 40 minutes of action in a game. Ashley Frazier leads the way as she has played all 40 minutes in 16-of-24 contests, including a 53-minute log during the triple-overtime win against Loyola Marymount and all 45 minutes against USC, and is averaging a Pac-10 leading 39.5 minutes per contest. Ibekwe (34.2), Reiko Thomas (33.0), Amina Njonkou (31.1), and Courtney Clements (29.9) are also logging heavy minutes for the Wildcats.

**Free Throw Findings:** One place the Wildcats have shown an improvement in 2008-09 versus last season is at the free throw line. After connecting at a .652 clip one season ago, the Cats currently own a 71.0 percent free throw percentage as a team, good for 89th in the NCAA. Clements leads the team with a .935 mark while Thomas checks in at .798 and Frazier has earned a .756 tally. The Cats have also limited the opportunities of the opposition, making 62 more free throws (333) than the opposition has attempted (271).

**Nearly Perfect:** Other than a 1-for-3 free throw shooting line against Arizona State on January 24, freshman Courtney Clements has gone perfect in every other game of the campaign. She made her first 19 attempts of the season, then missed back-to-back offerings against the Sun Devils. Since then, she has made 10-straight free throws to post a 29-for-31 mark. Though she

will have to significantly increase her attempts to reach the minimum standard to qualify for the school record books, a percentage over .900 would best the school mark of .893 (100-for-112) set by Kirsten Smith in 1986.

**Wiping the Glass:** The Wildcats continue to show their rebounding prowess as they have outrebounded the opposition in 13-of-24 contests thus far. The Cats are averaging 39.0 rebounds per game while allowing the opposition 36.8 rebounds each game. Arizona boasts a 8-5 record when outrebounding the opposition.

**National Notables:** Speaking of the NCAA statistics, Ibekwe is tops in the Pac-10 and is currently 7th in the NCAA in rebounds per game at 11.2. She is also 63rd in blocked shots per game at 1.9, 90th in scoring at 15.8 per contest and 97th in field goal percentage at .459. Ashley Frazier has moved to 84th in assists at 4.3 per game. The Wildcats are 16th in the NCAA in fouls committed per game with just 14.0 violations per contest.

**Topping the Charts:** Three times this season, Ibekwe has placed her name on the top 10 single-game rebounding list. She opened the season with 18 boards against Toledo, then grabbed 19 rebounds in a home victory against UC Santa Barbara nine days later before her 20-rebound output against Boise State.

**Incredible Ify:** It would be impossible to overstate the impact that Ibekwe had on the Arizona victory over Boise State. Her 26-point, 20-rebound performance was the first 20-20 game in program history and only the third in the NCAA at that point of 2008-09. She now owns three of the top four individual single-game rebounding totals in team history and is on pace to shatter the season record for rebounds per game of 10.8 set by the late Shawntinice Polk in the 2002-03 campaign. She is also on pace to register 15 double-doubles, a total that would place her just six behind Polk's 2003 total of 21 on the Arizona single-season list.

**Clement Time:** The recent 3-3 stretch of play by the Wildcats can at least partially be attributed to the improved and consistent play of freshman Courtney Clements. Over the past six games, Clements has scored 69 points, an average of 11.5 per contest. She has tallied in double figures in each of the last five games, including back-to-back 15-point outings against Washington State and Oregon State. She has also improved her accuracy from the field, connecting on 48 percent (24-of-50) in that stretch and 8-of-22 (.364) from three-point range. She has seen her per game scoring average a full 1.2 points to 8.8 and has made all five of her free throw attempts.

**Top of the Table:** Ibekwe is among the Pac-10 leaders in a number of categories as the Wildcats head down the final stretch of the regular season. Ibekwe leads the Pac-10 in rebounding, second in scoring and blocked shots, tied for third in steals and 10th in field goal percentage. Among her rebounding prowess, she is top of the heap in both offensive and defensive rebounds. Joining her among the league's elite is Ashley Frazier, who is tied for second in assists, and Amina Njonkou, who is tied for 5th in rebounding at 7.7 per game. As a team, the Cats are 3rd in field goal percentage defense, and 4th in rebounding offense, blocked shots and free throw percentage.

**Accepting the Accolades:** Not only was Ibekwe named the Pac-10 Player of the Week in December, she was recently named to the Naismith Award early season watch list. As one of 49 players and just three from the Pac-10 chosen to the initial list, Ibekwe will have an opportunity to remain on the semifinal list of 30 players when the Atlanta Tipoff Club has its voting members cast their ballots in February.

**Unlucky Number 18:** Despite the impressive individual outings by Ibekwe and Bofia in their 18-rebound efforts, the Wildcats came up on the losing end of each contest. However, the Cats made amends a week later by earning the win against UC Santa Barbara with the 19 rebounds tallied by Ibekwe. Including the other 10 games listed in the graphic above, the Wildcats are a perfect 4-0 when an Arizona player has at least 19 rebounds and 5-4 with a player tallying 18 rebounds.

**Block Party:** Last season, the Wildcats were one of the prominent teams in the Pac-10 when it came to blocked shots, finishing second in the league with 106 blocks for an average of 3.53 per game. Though the team's numbers are slightly down this season, Beatrice Bofia went a long way toward pushing the Cats back up that chart as she swatted a season-

career-best six shots against Oregon State. That total was good for a share of the 3rd-highest total in program history. Shawntinice Polk holds the single-game record at nine, set March 1, 2003 against California. On two occasions Polk had eight blocks while she also tallied six blocked shots in four other contests, a number originally set by Leslie Martin on December 14, 1981.

**Turn It Over:** Taking care of the ball has been an up-and-down proposition for the Wildcats this season. Through the first six games of the season, the Cats were averaging 22.3 miscues per contest. However, the team then went through a six-game stretch where the squad committed 15 or fewer turnovers. During Pac-10 play, the team has reverted more toward its opening trend of the season, averaging 19.1 turnovers per contest while forcing just 16.9 from the opposition.

**No Foul Play:** One area on the stat sheet that does seem to be falling in the favor of the Wildcats is personal fouls. The Cats have committed just 337 fouls through 24 games with only four foul-outs. With an average of just 14.0 fouls committed per game, the propensity not to foul as well as their solid conversion rate at the free throw line has helped the Wildcats make up for the 11.0 points lost per game in the three-point battle.

**Defending Their Home:** The Wildcats have shown that the McKale Center will not be an easy place for visiting teams to come in 2008-09. In eight home contests thus far, the Wildcats are allowing a meager 55.6 points per game on Olson Court. The Cats have held the opposition under 50 points on four occasions and allowed #9-ranked Texas A&M just 54 points while yielding only 56 to #6 California in a pair of hard-fought defeats.

**Keep It Down:** Arizona can look to its defense for ending its winless streak in Pac-10 play as the Wildcats held Washington and Oregon to an average of just 47.5 points per game. During its 7-game losing skid, the Wildcats had yielded 71.2 points per contest to the opposition. After allowing just 51 points in the victory over Washington, the defense put the clamps on Oregon and allowed a season-low 44 points. The Cats are 9-4 when allowing less than 62 points.

**Against All Odds:** The difficult slate of games the Wildcats face this season includes some impressive credentials boasted by its opponents. Of the 20 teams the Cats face during the 2008-09 campaign, eight of them were postseason participants. Six of those teams took part in the NCAA Tournament and amassed a record of 10-5 that included a run by Stanford to the championship game. Two other teams each went 1-1 in the postseason NIT and three of the eight teams won at least a share of their respective regular season conference titles.

**Working Their Way Up:** Arizona was handed the dubious honor of being picked last among all Pac-10 teams when the Preseason Coaches Poll was released in late October. Defending champion Stanford earned the top spot, edging Bay Area rival California by just two points thanks to a 6-4 advantage in first place votes. The Cats, meanwhile, got just 16 total points, finishing four points behind Washington State for 9th position. In the recently released media poll, the Wildcats were picked to finish 9th in the conference.

**Care To Speculate:** Sophomore Ify Ibekwe had an outstanding freshman campaign derailed for six games midway through the season after taking an elbow to the eye. She still managed to pull down 232 rebounds, good for 4th on the single-season list for freshmen. If she had been able to play in all 30 games and maintain her 8.0 average, she would have moved up to third position and would have recorded the 7th-best single season in school history for any class. Assuming Ibekwe played in 30 games for four seasons and kept her rebounding average the same, she would finish with 960 rebounds, a total that would make her the Wildcats' all-time leading rebounder ahead of current record holder Adia Barnes at 921. This season, she has pushed that mark to 11.2 per game through 24 games, an average that would leave her at 325 through 29 games, leaving her just 14 boards shy of the single-season record set by Shawntinice Polk in 2003-04.

**Up Next:** Arizona continues its three-game homestand next Thursday, February 26 when Washington State comes to McKale Center with tip-off scheduled for 7 p.m. The Wildcats will then play their final home contest of the season two days later, celebrating Senior Day against Washington at 2 p.m.
