Game 30: #9 Arizona (11-18) vs. #8 Washington State (11-18) Wildcats Open Pac-10 Tournament Against Cougars

Tip Off Time: Arizona begins postseason play as the #9 seed in the 2009 Pac-10 Tournament, held March 12-15 at the Galen Center on the campus of the University of Southern California. The Wildcats will play an opening round game against 8th-seeded Washington State on Thursday, March 12 starting at 8:15 p.m. The winner will face top-seeded Stanford the following day at 5:00 p.m.

Catch the Action: Entering his second season calling Arizona women's basketball games will be Derrick Palmer. He will be joined by Alysiah Bond, the Arizona women's basketball director of operations and former collegiate point guard at The Ohio State University. Wildcat games can be heard live on KTUC AM 1400. All broadcasts will start 30 minutes prior to tip-off for the pre-game show. Please visit www.arizonaathletics.com for all of your live stats, audio and video needs.

California Recap: For the second-straight game, Arizona battled back from a double-digit deficit in the latter stages of the game, but once again came up short in a 51-48 defeat at California on Saturday afternoon. The Wildcats closed a 12-point gap down to two in the final minute of the game, but were unable to break through for the victory. Ify Ibekwe tallied her 15th double-double of the season with game-highs of 21 points and 13 rebounds for the Wildcats while Ashley Frazier added nine points.

Head Coach Niya Butts:

Not only has the Arizona playing roster seen its share of turnover, but the coaching staff is also entirely new for the 2008-09 season. On April 3, 2008, Niya Butts was named the 8th coach in the history of Arizona women's basketball. Butts comes to Tucson after spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Kentucky. During her time with the Wildcats, she helped guide the team to a 88-72 record (.550) that included three WNIT appearances and a berth in the 2006 NCAA Tournament. Prior to her time in Lexington, Butts was an assistant coach at Michigan State during the 2002-03 season. That year, the Spartans made their first NCAA appearance in six seasons after posting an overall record of 17-12. She began her coaching career at Tennessee Tech, leading the Golden Eaglettes to back-to-back Ohio Valley Conference regular season titles in 2001 and 2002.

Butts is one of many head coaches in the NCAA ranks who played for the legendary Pat Summitt at the University of Tennessee, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in social work and a minor in psychology. A four-year letterwinner with the Lady Vols, Butts was a two-time NCAA champion (1997, 1998), three-time winner of the SEC championship (1998, 1999, 2000) and was chosen the SEC Defensive Player of the Year after her 1997 freshman campaign. She also excelled in the classroom and was three times named an Academic All-SEC selection (1998, 1999, 2000).

What Others Know About Niya:

Several prominent figures in the women's basketball scene weighed in following the hiring of Niya Butts to her Arizona post and provided their thoughts on her exploits and abilities.

Pat Summitt, University of Tennessee Head Coach

"Niya Butts is one of the bright young coaches in the women's collegiate game. I see this as a tremendous opportunity for her to take over the reins of her own program at Arizona and to compete in one of the nation's best conferences – the Pac 10. I see her taking the same qualities I saw in her as a player en route to two NCAA Championships – doing all the little things right – and applying them as a head coach at the University of Arizona."

Lin Dunn, Indiana Fever Head Coach

"Wow, Arizona sure hit the jackpot. The great thing about Niya is that she has the experience of playing at the championship level and she has great experience coaching in the SEC. That experience will benefit her in building Arizona into a national power. I can't think of a better young coach to take over at Arizona. She is the best of the best."

Matthew Mitchell, University of Kentucky Head Coach

"I am thrilled for Niya. She is extremely deserving of her position at Arizona. I have worked with no one in my career that has her unique combination of skills to excel as a coach. I have no doubt in my mind that she will turn Arizona into one of the top programs in the country that will last for many years. She helped take Kentucky from the bottom of the SEC to being one of the top-four teams in a short period of time, a testament to her ability to recruit and coach."

Mickie DeMoss, Former Kentucky Head Coach

"Niya is certainly one of the game's up and coming young coaches in the country. I've known her since 10th grade when I recruited her as a player to Tennessee. I had the opportunity to hire her at Kentucky, and she hit the road running, making a huge difference to that program, notably in recruiting. She is a driven young lady, very mature and very focused. Arizona is very fortunate to have her."

The Rest of the Staff

Sue Darling (Arizona '83): A former player at UA, Darling returns to the Old Pueblo to begin her 24th season in coaching. She has made coaching stops at the Air Force Academy, Northwestern, Dartmouth, Arizona State and with the Seattle Reign of the ABL. Darling was most recently the head girls' basketball coach at Mullen High School in Denver, Colo.

Brandy Manning (Clark Atlanta '02): The relative youngster of the staff, Manning is one of the most aggressive recruiters in the women's game today. Serving as the recruiting coordinator for the Wildcats, Manning spent last season at the University of Central Florida. He also has coaching experience from Murray State and the University of Louisville.

Chance Lindley (Wichita State, '00): Rounding out the staff is Chance Lindley, who joins the Wildcats after spending the 2007-08 season as the head coach at Barton County Community College. He led the Cougars to a 34-4 record and 4th place finish at the NJCAA championships. Lindley was instrumental in bringing shooting guard Ipek Turkyilmaz to Arizona as she was a key member of the Barton County team last season.

Do I Know You: The 2008-09 Arizona Wildcats roster consists of six returning players that will welcome seven newcomers to the fold. Among the returning players are two that earned all-Pac-10 honors and two others that saw considerable minutes in the latter half of the season.

Who's Back: Though the Wildcats were forced to say good-bye to leading scorer and 2nd-team all-Pacific-10 selection Ashley Whisonant, the team does return two players who were recognized with postseason accolades. Senior Amina Njonkou was an honorable mention all-conference selection in 2007-08, averaging 13.1 points per game while shooting just under 50 percent from the field and grabbing 7.4 rebounds per contest. Sophomore Ify Ibekwe completes the decorated duo, taking home all-Pac-10 Freshman team honors last season after tallying 10.4 points and a team-leading 8.0 rebounds per game. Fellow frontcourt players Sarah Hays and Beatrice Bofia return for their senior campaigns while sophomore perimeter players Tasha Dickey and Faiha Hill round out the group.

What's New: The fresh faces to the Arizona roster have a heavy California flavor as five of the seven players hail from the Golden State. Four of the five will battle for time in the backcourt: Amani Butler, Courtney Clements, Jhakia McDonald and Reiko Thomas. In the frontcourt, 6'5" Malia Nahinu will add size and depth to the frontcourt. On the perimeter, the Wildcats added a junior college transfer in ballhandler Ashley Frazier.

Series Notes: Arizona currently holds a 25-21 lead in the all-time series against Washington State dating back to the 1986-87 campaign. The Cougars have won the last three meetings between the two sides, including both contests this season, after Arizona had posted a three-game winning streak of its own. Thursday's game will be the first between the two teams on a neutral court.

Last Meeting: Without the services of leading scorer and rebounder Ify Ibekwe, the Wildcats were unable to defend their home floor against the Cougars as they dropped a 63-56 verdict two weeks ago. Amina Njonkou led the Wildcats with 16 points while Beatrice Bofia had 11 points and 12 rebounds. The Wildcats shot just 25 percent in the second half and were 2-of-18 from three-point range in the loss. Danielle LeNoir came off the bench to tally 15 points to lead the way for Washington State.

Scouting the Cougars: One of the youngest teams in the Pac-10, Washington State finished the 2008-09 season with an identical record as the Wildcats both overall (11-18) and in Pac-10 play (4-14). The Cougars enter the Pac-10 Tournament on the heels of back-to-back losses to Arizona State (76-35) and Washington (62-55). The Cougars average just two points more than the Cats, but allow almost six more on the defensive end. Arizona also holds an edge at the free throw line, connecting at a clip of almost .150 percentage points higher. Jazmine Perkins leads the Cougars in scoring at 13.9 per game while April Cook is not far behind at 13.7 per contest.

Future Cats: Head coach Niya Butts was happy to announce the signing of the first two players for the 2009 signing class earlier in the season. Senior guard Davellyn White of St. Mary's High School in Phoenix is the first prep player to sign a National Letter of Intent to play for Butts. Whyte, the daughter of former Major League Baseball veteran Devon White, averaged 18 points per game in her junior campaign, leading the Lady Knights to a 19-9 record and the 5A Desert Valley Region championship. She was an all-state selection and was the runner-up in the region player of the year voting. Whyte and the Lady Knights finished the 2008-09 season as the Division V-IA state runner-up after losing to Highland on Saturday, 51-48, coincidentally the same score as the Wildcats against the Golden Bears.

Joining Whyte with three years of eligibility remaining is Brooke Jackson, who is currently a freshman at Mesa Community College. A 5'9" shooting guard, Jackson prepped at Mountain View High School and was a two-time East Valley Region Player of the Year and two-time all-state selection. She is the 5A all-time single-season leader in scoring after tallying 849 points as a junior. Jackson also holds state 5A records for free throws made in a game (18) and season (216) as well as career steals (482). A solid outside shooter, Jackson finished her prep career with a 41 percent mark from three-point range. Jackson is averaging 18.2 points per game and was recently named the ACCAC Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year. She is shooting over 44 percent from beyond the arc for the 26-5 Lady Thunderbirds while also connecting on 86 percent of her free throws while dishing out 3.8 assists per game and swiping 2.7 steals per game. Mesa was the top seed in the ACCAC playoffs, but lost its opening game to Glendale last week.

Injury Update: Following a week of hard-fought contests, Arizona appears to be relatively healthy heading into the Pac-10 Tournament. Ify Ibekwe played all 40 minutes on Saturday against California after playing all but the first few minutes against Stanford two days earlier. This comes after Ibekwe injured her left knee two weeks ago in practice and missed games against the Washington schools at home. No other Wildcats are reporting any physical setbacks.

Postseason Pointers: Arizona is 6-7 all-time in the Pac-10 Tournament since its inception in 2002. The Cats have dropped their last two contests in the event, including a 46-31 opening round defeat last season against Oregon State. The Wildcats and Cougars have never met in the Pac-10 Tournament, one of three teams the Wildcats have yet to face in the event (California, UCLA). The Wildcats are the 9th seed for the fourth time and are 2-3 with that tag. The Cats had won their opening round games in each of their first two appearances (2006, 2007) as the 9th seed before losing last season. Stanford has been the biggest nemesis for Arizona, knocking the team out of the tournament on four occasions.

Friendly Confines: Other than playing at home inside McKale Center, the Galen Center has been a place that the Wildcats have enjoyed playing since its opening. The Cats have won their games against the Trojans in Los Angeles each of the past two seasons, including a convincing 74-61 win over USC back on Feb. 15. Arizona lost its first visit to the Galen Center in 2007 (66-42), but edged out a 64-62 victory last season and is 2-1 all-time at the new facility.

Going the Distance: With a roster depleted due to injuries, the active and healthy Wildcats have seen their share of minutes this season. Thirty-six times this season an Arizona player has

logged at least 40 minutes of action in a game. Ashley Frazier leads the way as she has played all 40 minutes in 21-of-29 contests, including a 53-minute log during the triple-overtime win against Loyola Marymount and all 45 minutes against USC, and is averaging a Pac-10 leading 39.6 minutes per contest. Ibekwe (34.8), Reiko Thomas (32.2), Amina Njonkou (30.4), and Courtney Clements (30.3) are also logging heavy minutes for the Wildcats.

Free Throw Findings: One place the Wildcats have shown an improvement in 2008-09 versus last season is at the free throw line. After connecting at a .652 clip one season ago, the Cats currently own a 72.5 percent free throw percentage as a team, good for 59th in the NCAA. Clements leads the team with a .938 mark while Thomas checks in at .819 and Frazier has earned a .745 tally. The Cats have also limited the opportunities of the opposition, making 52 more free throws (398) than the opposition has attempted (346).

Nearly Perfect: One miss in eight attempts was enough to end an impressive free throw streak put together by Courtney Clements over the past month. Following a 1-for-3 free throw shooting line against Arizona State on January 24, Clements had been perfect at the line. She made her first 19 attempts of the season, then missed back-to-back offerings against the Sun Devils. Since then, she had made 18-straight free throws before missing her first attempt against the Huskies on Saturday. She went on to make seven-straight to finish the game, giving her a chance to start a new streak through the rest of the season.

National Notables: In the latest release of the NCAA statistical leaders, Ibekwe is tops in the Pac-10 and is currently 5th in the NCAA in rebounds per game at 11.5. She is also 55th in blocked shots per game at 1.8. Reiko Thomas is 54th in free throw shooting with her .819 clip. The Wildcats are 17th in the NCAA in fouls committed per game with just 14.2 violations per contest.

Topping the Charts: With her latest dominating rebounding effort against Arizona State, Ify Ibekwe has placed her name on the top 10 single-game rebounding list four separate times this season. She opened the season with 18 boards against Toledo, then grabbed 19 rebounds in a home victory against UC Santa Barbara nine days later before her 20-rebound output against Boise State. She matched her performance against the Broncos on Saturday against Arizona State, providing just the third single-game performance with 20 or more rebounds.

Hunting History: Ify Ibekwe is rapidly approaching the end of a historical campaign with some lofty goals within reach. She had an outstanding freshman campaign derailed for six games midway through the season after taking an elbow to the eye, yet still managed to pull down 232 rebounds, good for 4th on the single-season list for freshmen. This season, she has already grabbed 288 rebounds, third-best for a single-season all-time and 2nd-best by any sophomore. Her latest injury, however, will more than likely leave her just shy of the school record. If she had been able to maintain her current average of 11.5 rebounds through the final four regular season games and at least one Pac-10 Tournament contest, Ibekwe would have eclipsed the single-season record of 339 set by Shawntinice Polk in 2003-04.

Incredible Ify: It would be impossible to overstate the impact that Ibekwe had on the Arizona victory over Boise State on December 29. Her 26-point, 20-rebound performance was the first 20-20 game in program history and only the third in the NCAA at that point of 2008-09. She now owns three of the top four individual single-game rebounding totals in team history and is on pace to shatter the season record for rebounds per game of 10.8 set by the late Shawntinice Polk in the 2002-03 campaign. She has also registered 15 double-doubles, a total that places her just six behind Polk's 2003 total of 21 on the Arizona single-season list.

Clement Time: The improved and consistent play of freshman Courtney Clements over the past 11 games has gone a long way toward the Wildcats having a solid second half of Pac-10 play. Clements has scored 136 points, an average of 12.4 per contest. She has tallied in double figures in 9-of-11 games, including back-to-back 15-point outings against Washington State and Oregon State and a career-high 22 points against Washington. She has seen her per game scoring average climb a full 2.1 points to 9.7 while making 25-of-26 free throws.

Top of the Table: Ibekwe is among the Pac-10 leaders in a number of categories as the Wildcats head down the final stretch of the regular season. Ibekwe leads the Pac-10 in rebounding, is second in scoring and blocked shots, fourth in steals and 11th in field goal percentage. Among her rebounding prowess, she is top of the heap in both offensive and

defensive rebounds. Joining her among the league's elite is Ashley Frazier, who is 3rd in assists, and Amina Njonkou, who is 5th in rebounding and 8th in field goal percentage. As a team, the Cats are 3rd in field goal percentage defense, and 4th in rebounding offense, blocked shots and free throw percentage.

Accepting the Accolades: Not only was Ibekwe named the Pac-10 Player of the Week in December, she was also named to the Naismith Award early season watch list. As one of 49 players and just three from the Pac-10 chosen to the initial list, Ibekwe will have an opportunity to remain on the semifinal list of 30 players when the Atlanta Tipoff Club has its voting members cast their ballots in February.

Unlucky Number 18: Despite the impressive individual outings by Ibekwe and Bofia in their 18-rebound efforts, the Wildcats came up on the losing end of each contest. However, the Cats made amends a week later by earning the win against UC Santa Barbara with the 19 rebounds tallied by Ibekwe. Including the other 10 games listed in the graphic above, the Wildcats are a perfect 4-0 when an Arizona player has at least 19 rebounds and 5-4 with a player tallying 18 rebounds.

Block Party: Last season, the Wildcats were one of the prominent teams in the Pac-10 when it came to blocked shots, finishing second in the league with 106 blocks for an average of 3.53 per game. Though the team's numbers are slightly down this season, Beatrice Bofia went a long way toward pushing the Cats back up that chart as she swatted a season- and career-best six shots against Oregon State. That total was good for a share of the 3rd-highest total in program history. Shawntinice Polk holds the single-game record at nine, set March 1, 2003 against California. On two occasions Polk had eight blocks while she also tallied six blocked shots in four other contests, a number originally set by Leslie Martin on December 14, 1981.

No Foul Play: One area on the stat sheet that does seem to be falling in the favor of the Wildcats is personal fouls. The Cats have committed just 413 fouls with only six foul-outs. With an average of just 14.2 fouls committed per game, the propensity not to foul as well as their solid conversion rate at the free throw line has helped the Wildcats make up for the 10.5 points lost per game in the three-point battle.

Defending Their Home: The Wildcats have shown that the McKale Center was not going to be an easy place for visiting teams to come in 2008-09. In 14 home contests, the Wildcats allowed a meager 56.9 points per game on Olson Court. The Cats held the opposition under 50 points on four occasions and allowed #9-ranked Texas A&M just 54 points while yielding only 56 to #6 California in a pair of hard-fought defeats.

Keep It Down: Arizona can look to its defense for ending its winless streak in Pac-10 play as the Wildcats held Washington and Oregon to an average of just 47.5 points per game. During its 7-game losing skid, the Wildcats had yielded 71.2 points per contest to the opposition. After allowing just 51 points in the victory over Washington, the defense put the clamps on Oregon and allowed a season-low 44 points. The Cats are 9-5 when allowing less than 62 points.

Against All Odds: The difficult slate of games the Wildcats face this season includes some impressive credentials boasted by its opponents. Of the 20 teams the Cats face during the 2008-09 campaign, eight of them were postseason participants. Six of those teams took part in the NCAA Tournament and amassed a record of 10-5 that included a run by Stanford to the championship game. Two other teams each went 1-1 in the postseason NIT and three of the eight teams won at least a share of their respective regular season conference titles.

Working Their Way Up: Arizona was handed the dubious honor of being picked last among all Pac-10 teams when the Preseason Coaches Poll was released in late October. Defending champion Stanford earned the top spot, edging Bay Area rival California by just two points thanks to a 6-4 advantage in first place votes. The Cats, meanwhile, got just 16 total points, finishing four points behind Washington State for 9th position. In the recently released media poll, the Wildcats were picked to finish 9th in the conference.

Up Next: With each game providing a do-or-die scenario for the Wildcats, it will take a victory over the Cougars to prolong the 2008-09 season. Should that occur, Arizona would battle #1-seeded Stanford on Friday, March 13 at 5:00 p.m. (PST)
