Las Vegas, Ariz.**

The Event: The University of Arizona Wildcat women's golf team will continue the spring season with the UNLV Invitational. Held at the Cascata Golf Club, competition will take place Mon.-Tues., Feb. 20-21. The Cascata Golf Club is a par 72, 6,200-yard course with 500-600 feet in elevation changes.

The Coverage: Live results are available at golfstat.com. A complete recap and results will be available at ArizonaWildcats.com after each day of competition.

The Field: Arizona, BYU, Colorado State, Idaho, Louisville, New Mexico, New Mexico State, North Texas, San Diego State, UC Irvine and UNLV will play in Las Vegas this weekend.

The Line Up: Seniors Isabelle Boineau, Nikki Koller and Margarita Ramos and freshmen Manon Gidali and Andrea Vilarasau will play for the Arizona team this weekend.

The Rankings: Arizona is currently ranked No. 9 by the *Golfweek/Sagarin* Poll (2/12/12), No. 15 by *Golfstat* (2/15/12) and No. 23 by the *Golf World/NGCA Coaches' Poll* (11/28/11).

Last Time Out: With individual and team records set, the Wildcats won their only home event of the season, the Wildcat Invitational. No. 22 Arizona finished atop the leader board with rounds of 285, 274 and 292 for a total of 851 (-13). UA's three-round total is a school record over 54 holes, replacing the previous best of 854 (-10), set by the 1998-99 squad at Randolph North Course, in Tucson. No. 1 UCLA earned a runner-up finish with rounds of 289, 283 and 291 for a total of 863 (-1). No. 8 Arizona State rounded out the top three with a score of 884 (+20). The Sun Devils had scores of 291, 296 and 297.

UA freshman Manon Gidali, competing in her first collegiate tournament, won the individual title with rounds of 67, 66 and 71 for a three-round total of 204 (-12). Her

rounds of 66 and 67 rank tied for No. 2 and tied for No. 6, respectively, all-time at Arizona. Gidali's three day total of 204 (-12) is a new school record over 54 holes, replacing Lorena Ochoa's previous best of 206 (-10) from Trysting Tree Golf Club (Corvallis, Ore.) in 2001.

Busy Schedule: Arizona will have a busy slate with the 2011 fall and 2012 spring competition schedules. Fall trips include Chicago, Ill., Knoxville, Tenn. and Austin, Texas. Spring trips include Las Vegas, Nev., San Diego, Calif. and San Francisco, Calif. The championships season begins with the Pac-12 Championships, April 27-29, in Pullman, Wash.

Welcome Back: Arizona welcomes back seniors Isabelle Boineau, Nikki Koller and Margarita Ramos, junior Kyndall Ardoin and sophomore Haley Andreas from the 2010-11 squad that finished second at the Pac-10 Championships, fifth at the NCAA West Regional Championships and ended the season with a 15th-place finish at the NCAA Championships. Manon Gidali, Paige Spiranac and Andrea Vilarasau will join the team as true freshmen with Clemence Abrahamian joining as a junior transfer.
