**The Event:** The University of Arizona Wildcat women's golf team will continue the spring season with the Pacific Coast Intercollegiate, hosted by UC Davis and Oregon. Held at Half Moon Bay Golf Links (Ocean Course) in Half Moon Bay, Calif, competition will take place Mon.-Tues., April 16-17. The Half Moon Bay Golf Links Ocean Course is a par 72, 6,034-yard course. The 54-hole tournament will be played over the course of two days, with 36 holes played on Monday and 18 played on Tuesday. Tee times for both days will be at 8 a.m. PT.

**The Coverage:** Live results are available at golfstat.com. A complete recap and results will be available at ArizonaWildcats.com after each day of competition.

**The Field:** The field for the tournament features seven teams ranked in the top-25, according to Golfstat, and two top-10 ranked teams. Competing this weekend will be No. 1 UCLA, No. 3 USC, No. 14 California, No. 16 Oklahoma State, No. 19 Arizona, No. 21 Oregon, No. 23 UC Davis, No. 29 Washington, No. 40 Stanford, No. 53 Oregon State, No. 66 Long Beach State, No. 71 San Jose State, No. 75 UC Irvine, No. 79 Washington State and No. 81 Fresno State (Golfstat rankings as of April 11).

**The Line Up:** Seniors Isabelle Boineau, Nikki Koller and Margarita Ramos, freshman Manon Gidali and junior Kyndall Ardoin will play for the Arizona team this weekend.

**The Rankings:** Arizona is currently ranked No. 15 by the *Golfweek/Sagarin* Poll (3/25/12), No. 19 by Golfstat (4/11/12) and No. 13 by the *Golf World/NGCA Coaches' Poll* (2/29/12).

**Conference Honors:** Freshman Manon Gidali was named the Pac-12 Women's Golfer of the Month. In February, she paced Arizona to a 12-stroke win at the Wildcat Invitational and a 19-stroke win at the UNLV Invitational. **Busy Schedule:** Arizona will have a busy slate with the 2011 fall and 2012 spring competition schedules. Fall trips include Chicago, Ill., Knoxville, Tenn. and Austin, Texas. Spring trips include Las Vegas, Nev., San Diego, Calif. and San Francisco, Calif. The championships season begins with the Pac-12 Championships, April 27-29, in Pullman, Wash.

**Welcome Back:** Arizona welcomes back seniors Isabelle Boineau, Nikki Koller and Margarita Ramos, junior Kyndall Ardoin and sophomore Haley Andreas from the 2010-11 squad that finished second at the Pac-10 Championships, fifth at the NCAA West Regional Championships and ended the season with a 15th-place finish at the NCAA Championships. Manon Gidali, Paige Spiranac and Andrea Vilarasau will join the team as true freshmen with Clemence Abrahamian joining as a junior transfer.
