The Event: The University of Arizona Wildcat women's golf team will continue the spring season with the PING/ASU Invitational, hosted by Arizona State. Held at ASU Karsten Golf Course in Tempe, Ariz., competition will take place Fri.-Sun., April 12-14. With one round played each day, tee times are scheduled for 8 a.m. Friday and 7:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. ASU Karsten Golf Course is a par 72 over 6,223 yards.

The Coverage: Live results are available at golfstat.com. A complete recap and results will be available at ArizonaWildcats.com after each day of competition.

The Lineup: Sophomores Patricia Garcia, Manon Gidali and Andrea Vilarasau and freshmen Janie Jackson and Anna Kim will play for the Arizona team this weekend. Sophomore Kendall Prince will play as an individual. Individually, Gidali is ranked No. 24 and Prince is ranked No. 46 by *Golfweek/Sagarin* (4/7/13).

The Field: No. 3 Alabama, No. 7 Arizona, No. 13 Arizona State, California, Colorado, No. 2 Duke, Oregon, South Carolina, No. 16 Stanford, No. 22 Texas, No. 25 Texas A&M, TCU, No. 15 UC Davis, No. 11 UCLA, UNLV, No. 1 USC and No. 9 Washington will play in Tempe, Ariz. this weekend. (*Rankings according to golfstat.com 4/8/13*)

Last Time Out: With a runner-up finish from sophomore Manon Gidali, UA earned a second-place finish at the SDSU Farms Invitational. Arizona finished second with an 896 (+32) and rounds of 306, 298 and 292. Just one stroke out of the lead, No. 33 Gidali earned a runner-up finish in the field of 81. She fired rounds of 72, 76 and 70 for a score of 218 (+2). She now totals 10 rounds at or below par on the season. Gidali moved from tied for fifth to second on the final day of play.

In The Fall: Arizona's lineup stayed consistent and so did the performances. The squad didn't finish outside the top four and won two events at the Mason Rudolph Championship and the Windy City Collegiate Classic.

Sophomore Manon Gidali paced the Cats with a 73.11 stroke average this fall. She also collected two top-10 finishes and four rounds at or below par. Freshman Janie Jackson holds the season-low round of 68, shot at the Stanford Intercollegiate.

Busy Schedule: Arizona will have a busy slate with the 2013 spring competition schedule. Trips include Palos Verdes, Calif., Los Angeles, Calif., Honolulu, Hawaii, San Diego, Calif. and Tempe, Ariz. The championships season begins with the Pac-12 Championships, April 22-24, in Los Angeles, Calif., hosted by UCLA.

Welcome Back: Arizona welcomes back junior Haley Andreas and sophomores Manon Gidali and Andrea Vilarasau from the 2011-12 squad that finished third at the Pac-12 Championships and ninth at the NCAA West Regional Championships. Janie Jackson and Anna Kim join the team as true freshmen and Patricia Garcia and Kendall Prince are sophomore transfers.
