TOP 25 POLL DIVISION I WOMEN

Out of the SEC, Georgia unanimously maintains the top ranking in the country for the second 2011-2012 poll. Indiana jumps six spots to #8 and earns the highest ranking out of the Big 10. Both the SEC and the Big 10 top the rankings by each landing six teams in the Top 25 while the Pac 12, lead by Cal, shows its depth by ranking four teams in the top six. Southern Methodist jumps seven spots to land at #13 and again is the only team ranked from outside of the major conferences. Out of the Big 12, Texas continues to maintain the highest lead of the conference at #4, while the ACC is led by #11 Virginia as they tie with #13 Southern Methodist as the biggest jumpers of the second poll of the year. #19 Louisville continues its reign on the Big East as the sole ranked team from the conference. The Big 10 and the SEC both debut new teams in the poll with Wisconsin and Arkansas coming in at #16 and #20 respectively.
