Arizona Wins Pac-10 Tournament

The Arizona women's tennis team took home the trophy at the Pac-10 Tournament last weekend in Ojai, Calif. The Wildcats won the tourney after tallying the most individual wins, despite dropping two doubles matches in the final round of the main and invitational draws. The tournament title is the first for the Wildcats in 10 years.

Moving Up in the Rakings

Arizona moved up individually in the rankings this week. The team moved to No. 22, while graduate student Emilie Scribot moved to No. 5. Also moving up for the Cats were sophomores Maja Mlakar and Dianne Hollands. Mlakar moved to No. 29, and Hollands improved to No. 45. In doubles, Arizona's duo of Mlakar and Scribot improved their ranking to No. 24.

Head Coach Vicky Maes

In her first year of coaching at theUA since graduating from Arizona in 1999 with a BS in business administration, Coach Maes brough the Arizona women's tennis team from an initial national ranking of 54, to the team's final ranking of 19. In her second year as head coach, Maes hopes to further advance the team's success. In fall play, Maes and the Wildcat women's tennis team recorded several wins, highlighted by a sweep of the singles and doubles titles at the Fall Desert Classic in Palm Springs, Calif. In the regular season, Maes has led the Wildcats to a record of 9-11, 3-5 in the Pac-10.
