2007 SEASON IN REVIEW

ALL-AMERICANS: Caitlin Lowe and Taryne Mowatt were named to the first and second NFCA All-America teams, respectively. Lowe became just the second player in Arizona history to earn first-team All-America honors all four years. Mowatt's citation was the first in her career, but marked the 17th consecutive year Arizona has had a pitcher named to the All-America team. Additionally, 2007 is the 18th consecutive year that UA had at least two players named All-Americans.

ALL-PAC-10: Caitlin Lowe, Kristie Fox and Taryne Mowatt earned All-Pac-10 first-team honors, while Chelsie Mesa was listed on the second team. Arizona head coach Mike Candrea was cited as the Pac-10 Coach of the Year for the 10th time. Additionally, Lowe was named the Conference's Defensive Player of the Year. Callista Balko and Adrienne Acton were tabbed for honorable mentions.

PAC-10 ALL-ACADEMIC: Arizona outfielder Jill Malina was named to the Pac-10 All-Academic second team.

ALL-PACIFIC REGION TEAM: Three Wildcats — Taryne Mowatt, Caitlin Lowe and Callista Balko — were named to the NFCA's all-Pacific



Pitcher Taryne Mowatt was named second-team NFCA All-America after posting a school-record 42 wins.

Region first team. The honor was a first for both Mowatt and Balko, while Lowe was named to the all-region first team for the fourth time.

HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF: Arizona has experienced exceptional success in years following a national title. The Wildcats have appeared in the national title game after every one of their national championships, have won six of seven Pac-10 Championships and average a 60-7 record in those seven campaigns.

ARIZONA SOFTBALL ATTENDANCE: Arizona repeated as the NCAA Champion — in home game attendance. In 29 dates, Arizona hosted 44,487 fans for an average of 1,534 per date. Even more impressive is Arizona's average of 2,093 fans in Pac-10 contests.

Since Hillenbrand Stadium's opening in 1993, 459,866 fans have passed through the turnstiles.

UA on TV: Arizona had 14 of its games televised, all but two of which were shown to a national audience. UA went 10-3-1 in those games, which includes a 2-1-1 mark in Pac-10 contests and 8-2 record in postseason games. Since 2005, UA has had a total of 41 of its games televised, 37 of which were televised on one of ESPN's family of networks.

UA on TV

Arizona had 12 of its games televised nationally, half of which came at the WCWS. UA went 9-3 in those games.

During the regular season, ESPN2 televised Arizona's 1-0 loss to Texas, UA's first defeat of the year, and FSN carried the Arizona-Stanford game on April 21 in Palo Alto via tape delay, a 4-1 UA victory. In the postseason, Arizona's Tucson Regional-clinching 4-2 victory over Auburn was televised live on ESPN2, while all three super regional games against LSU were picked up by ESPN2 or ESPN. Finally at the WCWS, all six of UA's games were televised on either ESPN or ESPN2.

In 2005, Arizona had 15 of its games televised live on one of ESPN's networks.

Arizona Softball Attendance

Once again Arizona's loyal fans showed up in bunches during the 2006 season. In 26 home dates, 33,594 bodies pushed through the turnstiles, averaging 1,292 per date. Arizona drew over 1,000 fans in 19 of its 26 home dates.

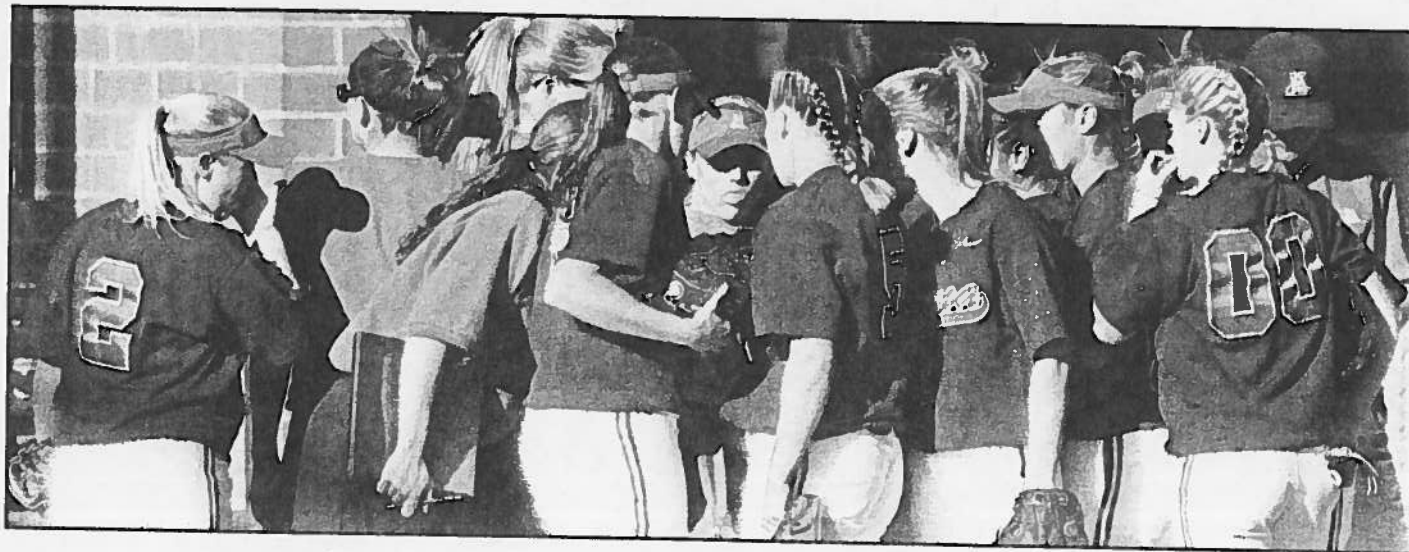

1997 Senior Review

Arizona enters 1998 without three players who each turned in outstanding performances in Wildcat uniforms. They helped Arizona compile a record of 249-23 in the last four years and helped the Cats win three NCAA Championships -- a feat accomplished by only two other players in NCAA history -- former teammates Jenny Dalton and Krista Gomez.

Leah O'Brien, All-American

Actually, O'Brien, a three-time first-team All-America pick, was part of a 93-31 UA record since she started in 1993, then took 1996 off to win a gold medal on the U.S. Olympic softball team. A lock for the Arizona Sports Hall of Fame, O'Brien's skill was exemplified in one week last year: when she went on a tear at the College World Series -- collecting nine hits, six RBI and four runs. Her .428 career batting average is No. 1 in the UA record book, one of the 19 categories her name appears in. An exemplary clutch player, she was a three-time All-CWS selection.

Brandi Shriver, All-American

Outfielder Brandi Shriver is No. 6 in UA's record book with a .352 average and employed speed and savvy to get the job done time and again. She had five hits in last year's CWS and batted .423 in 26 series appearances over four years. She was a second-team All-America pick in 1996 and an All-College World Series selection in 1995.

Carrie Dolan, All-American

Pitcher Carrie Dolan leaves as Arizona's career pitching victories leader with a record of 103-13. She was a first-team All-America selection in 1995 with a 33-2 record and a second-team pick in 1996 with a 35-6 record. Last year she finished 24-3 and beat eight ranked teams. Additionally the 1998 Wildcats will be without the services of junior shortstop Lisa Pitt and sophomore catcher Lindsay Mullins, who left the program last fall.

1996 Senior Review

Arizona enters 1997 with the services of two departed seniors -- but in new capacities as student assistant coaches. They helped UA compile a record of 232-26 in their four years, helped set a record with 66 victories in 1995, and won three national championships -- as many as any softball players in NCAA history.

Jenny Dalton

National Player of the Year

A three-time first-team All-America selection, Dalton won the Honda Softball Award as the nation's best player in 1996, a season in which she punctuated an outstanding career with the first Triple Crown in Pac-10 history -- .469 batting average, 25 home runs and 109 RBI. Those numbers represent careers for most college players but Dalton did it time and again and left the game with NCAA career records in RBI (328), runs scored (293), walks (178), slugging percentage (.815), career RBI per game (1.31) and the NCAA single-season marks of 64 walks (1996) and 101 runs cored (1995). Twice she tied an NCAA record with three home runs in a game. She was a two-time Academic All-American as well, and topped her career with the College World Series MVP honor. She was arguably the most dangerous line-drive hitter in the game for four years.

Krista Gomez

1996 All-America

A versatile player who played second base one year -- winning All-College World Series honors as a freshman -- outfield and then two seasons at third, Gomez capped her career with second-team All-America honors, All-Pacific-10 and All-Pacific Region honors, as well as her second All-College World Series selection. She finished with a career batting average of .358 (sixth best in Arizona history), stole 39 bases in 43 attempts, and scored 159 runs (sixth most on the UA chart). Aside from the numbers, Gomez' contribution was exceptional for her team-oriented play, toughness in the clutch and big-play style.

Senior Review

Arizona enters 1996 without the services of two 1995 graduates — two of the finest players in collegiate softball history:

Amy Chellevoid, All-America First Baseman

Mike Candrea was able to pencil in the best leadoff hitter in the nation at the top of his lineup for four years and 255 games. She did what was needed — get on base and score runs — Chellevoid is the NCAA career record holder in hits (371) and runs scored (252). She has the top two batting averages in UA history, .504 in '94 and .443 in '95, and the top career average, .415. Best of all, her career fielding average was .995 with only 12 errors in 1,817 chances. Arizona's first four-time All-American and four-time first-team All-Pacific-10 Conference player. (Along with the following player). She was a Pacific-10 Conference Medal honoree in June for all-around scholastic and athletic accomplishments. She has joined the UA coaching staff this year.

Laura Espinoza, All-American Shortstop

The most prolific slugger in national history, Espinoza set a couple of records a year ago — 37 home runs and 128 RBIs — that will be tough to plug back into UA's lineup, to say the least. Her career figures of 85 home runs and 314 RBIs are also at the top of the NCAA's lists. Alone, she set 10 national power hitting records and tied two others last season. She hit for average, too, second only to Chellevoid at .437 a year ago and second on the UA career chart with a .366 mark. "Pegale!" (hit it) was a UA chant when Espinoza stepped to the plate, and she did, plenty of times. She, too, became UA's first four-time All-Pac-10 first-team selection and was a three-time All-American.
